

## Psidium Guajava

Ideally plant in seedling trays or a small pot for transplanting later on.

Use a mix of sand, peat moss and potting soil.

Plant the seeds at 5mm.

Allow up to 6 weeks for germination to occur ensuring that the soil is kept moist during this time.

Once seedlings grow and they reach a height of 5cm, you will need to transplant. Guajava does well in a large pot or in the garden. Ensure that when transplanting that the soil is well aerated and kept moist.
