

## **Summer Savory**

Spread 2 inches of compost over a well-drained, full sun planting site. Work the compost into the top 8 inches of soil, breaking up any large soil clods as you work it in.

Sow the seeds 1/8 inch deep, setting two seeds in each planting hole. Space the seeds 3 inches apart in rows that are spaced 2 to 3 feet apart.

Mist the soil with water until the top 3 to 6 inches feels moist to the touch. Water as needed to maintain the moisture in the soil.

Thin the plants once they produce their second set of leaves. Pull up the excess plants so the remaining ones are spaced approximately 10 inches apart along each row.
