Avoid Extreme Heat

Your Aurora Shoes have Vibram © Evaflex soles which can be damaged by exposure to concentrated heat or extreme temperatures. Keep Aurora Shoes away from campfires, fireplaces, and indoor radiators. If your shoes become wet, allow them to air dry slowly, away from direct heat.

Renew or Replace Worn Soles

If your unique gait causes your soles to wear unevenly, return them for repair promptly to ensure your feet remain correctly supported and balanced.

Shoes that are ready for repair have retained their softness and are free of cracks in the leather.

Clean and Protect

Scuff marks are easily removed with a damp soft cloth. Try soap and water or a mild leather cleaner to remove stubborn stains.

Our leather uppers are vegetable re-tanned and hand glazed using a blend of natural oils. This formula allows our shoes to withstand repeated wettings and stay dry and soft.

Eventually your shoes will need to be replenished with oils to keep the leather from drying and cracking. Most any leather conditioner will do the trick. We recommend that you stick to a natural formula that contains any of the following active ingredients: neatsfoot oil, lanolin, mink oil, or pressed lard oils.
