It's not a turkey fryer, but the Orion Cooker certainly can cook up one as moist and as quickly. The OC is like a traditional charcoal grill, but in reverse. You load the outside and top with charcoal and place your chicken, ribs, brisket, turkey and whatever you can think of inside the stainless steel chamber, where it cooks like a convection oven. The meat stays moist, the cooking times are dramatically reduced and it can also smoke and flavor the meat with the addition of wood chips and liquids like beer, wine or juice.

Make quick work of the hard-to-reach spots around the nooks and crannies of your yard with the "world's lightest gas-powered string trimmer" from Homelite. In our tests, the trimmer was indeed light, but we found the fuel capacity to also be on the small side. Performance-wise, it was a joy to wield and made quick work of the edge of the lawn. The 26cc engine proved to be plenty of power, and starting it was a cinch with the fingertip pull start.
