Installing a Cutting Board attachment to a TemboTusk flat slide.

The work is best done while the slide is bolted in the vehicle or on a work bench.

The slide pan needs to be in the upper configuration to start. To determine pan position, look at the side of the slide and locate the track bolt heads. If the tracks are in the upper bolt holes you are good to go.

If the pan is in the lower configuration, the slide tracks will need to raise to the upper holes. Please follow the procedure below:

Lifting the fridge tray to the upper position: Extend the fridge tray. Locate the rear bolts holding the stationary section of the slide track to the base of the flat slide. Use a 5/32 Allen wrench and a 7/16 socket wrench to remove the fasteners. The base section of the track has four bolts on each side. Start with the rear bolts, using the Allen and socket wrench to remove the button bolts from both tracks. Slide out the track to locate the front two nuts. There is a cutout in the track for locating the front fasteners. Remove the bolts from the front of both tracks. With all the four bolts from each stationary track removed, the fridge tray can now be lifted one side at a time and reattached in the upper position.

Installing the Cutting Board Attachment: Slide the entire cutting board assembly under the fridge pan. (It is sometimes easier to pull the fridge pan out a few inches to give working room.) Locate and line up the fridge pan holes with the cutting board attachment points. Using a 5/32 Allen wrench, attach the button head bolts loosely on one side first. If the pan and cutting board don't line up for the second track, you may need to loosen the cutting board pan to give the second track enough room to line up with the holes. Once all the bolts are in place, re-tighten the cutting board pan in place. Finish tightening the cutting board assembly to the fridge pan.
