

# APPLYING Keratin Bonded Extensions



## WE RECOMMEND:

- One Jar of Keratin Glue
- One Adhesive Melting Pot
- Six Duckbill Clips
- Two Placement Disks
- Talc Powder w/Brush
- One set of Pliers

## YOU MAY ALSO NEED:

- Liquid Gold Clarifying Shampoo
- Salon Pro 30-sec. Remover
- Refresh Dry Shampoo

The above items are available at Abantu instore and online.

You've may a great choice. **Crystalized Keratin** is an excellent natural oil adhesive and does not damage your hair, even after repeated applications. Keratin can last two to four months and is suitable for many quality brands of human hair available instore and online at Abantu.

## PREPARATION

### WASH & DRY

- Shampoo with **Liquid Gold Clarifying Shampoo**. When hair is completely dry application may begin.



*DO NOT use any conditioner*

### HEATING THE GLUE

- Place the Adhesive Melting Pot on a flat surface and plug into a wall outlet or approved extension cord.
- Place 3-4 pearls into the Pot. Add more as needed. (Keratin takes 2-4 minutes to melt).



*DO NOT overfill the Pot. Avoid putting too much Keratin on the hair.*

### HAIR PREPARATION

- Separate a small section of your natural hair around the thickness of the shaft of a Q-tip and surround it with a placement disk. Use a duckbill clip to hold it in place.



*Ensure the section of your natural hair is equal to the thickness of the extension hair being attached*

- Carefully cut the extension hair off the weft.
- Fan out the extension hair and dip 1/4" of the blunt end into the warmed Pot. Remove any excess Keratin from the extension hair.

# APPLICATION

## BOND THE EXTENSION HAIR

- Dampen your fingertips with water before applying the extensions hair. This will encapsulate and crystallize the Keratin glue for better results.
- With your free hand pull the sectioned piece of hair away from the head and align the dipped extension hair on top, no closer than 1/4" away from the scalp.
- Pinch and roll the hair between moistened thumb and forefinger, creating a tight cylinder.
- Repeat the steps for each new section of extension hair to be applied.

## SEAL THE BONDED HAIR

- With a brush, apply talc or baby powder to the finished bonds to both dry and seal the Keratin.


 *Brush talc or baby powder to dry the bonds if they become sticky following showering, bathing etc..*

 *Use Refresh Dry Shampoo on bonds to remove moisture at least once per week*

# REMOVAL

- To break the bonds, position pliers over the bonded hair and 'crack' the Keratin glue. Repeat until the bond completely breaks apart. Use fingernails to scratch and crumble remaining Keratin residue from the natural hair.

 *DO NOT pull the hair until the bond is completely broken apart*

 *Should glue remain, place 2-3 drop of Salon Pro 30 Second Remover on thumb and forefinger and work through the hair*

- Gently separate your natural hair from the extension hair.
- After removal of the extensions, shake hair vigorously and brush thoroughly. Use a fine-toothed comb to help remove any leftover residue from your natural hair.
- Shampoo 2-3 times as needed.
- Deep condition hair, dry and style as desired.

# DO NOT



- Retouch or colour your hair before applying extensions
- Under any circumstance, submerge your head or ringer in the warmed Adhesive Melting Pot. This may result in serious injury
- Use a flat iron or blow dryer on the Crystallized Keratin bonds
- Submerge head in hot tub, or use saunas
- Use glues other than approved Keratin or Torain Glue Stick, in the AMP

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
