

NEVER HAVE I EVER SHAWL

Not a pattern!

It's a get to know you game you can play with your knitting.

This page is blank to avoid unwanted spoilers.

DESCRIPTION

Use this shawl as an icebreaker to introduce yourself to your fellow yarn club members! This isn't a pattern, it is the knitting version of the drinking game Never Have I Ever. Instead of doing a shot, you knit in garter stitch.

Every second stripe there's a "never have I ever". For example, for the first green stripe it's "Never have I ever knit on an airplane". If you have knit on an airplane, then you'll work the green stripe in garter stitch. If you haven't, then you'll continue in stockinette.

Use the Hydrogen Shawl or any other simple triangular shawl as your blank canvas.

INSTRUCTIONS

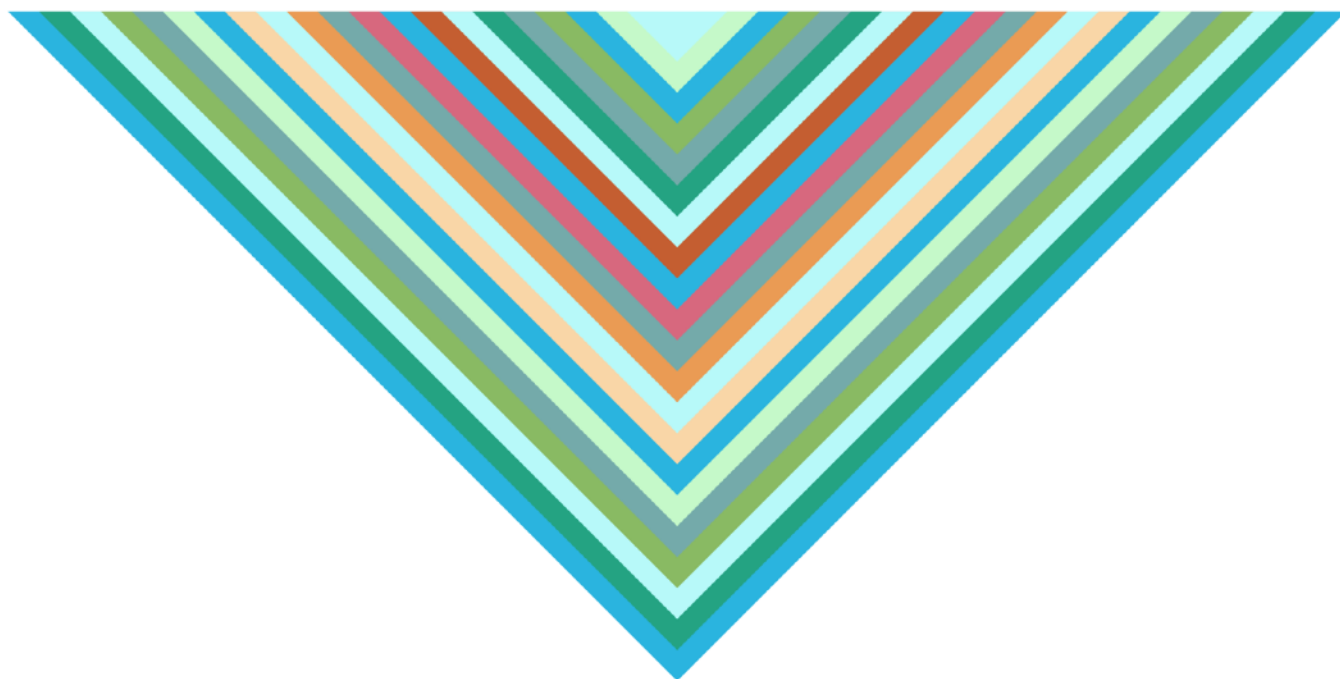
OVERVIEW

Using the shawl pattern of your choice, cast on at the pale blue end of the yarn. Continue knitting until the colour changes from pale blue to pale green.

The yarn alternates between blue stripes (three different blues) and colourful (not blue) stripes. For each row, continue working the edge and increase stitches as established.

Colourful stripes: refer to the Never Have I Ever section on the next page. If you have *never* done that thing, work this section in stockinette (knit on right side, purl on wrong side). If you *have* done that thing, switch to garter stitch (knit every row) for the rest of that stripe.

Blue stripes: work in stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side).



NEVER HAVE I EVER

1 (Pale Green) : Never have I ever knit on an airplane.

2 (Medium Green) : Never have I ever felted a finished hand knit by accident.

3 (Dark Green) : Never have I ever used my rings as stitch markers.

Pssst. Are you remembering to do all your increases in the right places? Just checking. If you missed one, don't even worry about it. Your stitch count isn't critical and no one will notice. On the other hand, if you forget about them entirely this will be a very weird triangle so consider this a gentle reminder.

4 (Dark Orange) : Never have I ever brought my knitting to a movie theatre.

5 (Pink) : Never have I ever knit anything for a pet.

6 (Medium Orange) : Never have I ever used chopsticks to eat snacks while knitting.

7 (Peach) : Never have I ever lost at yarn chicken.

8 (Pale Green) : Never have I ever broken a needle while knitting.

9 (Medium Green) : Never have I ever had a swatch that lied.

10 (Dark Green) : Never have I ever knit with self-striping yarn. (You are doing this right now. Work this section in garter stitch. This will create a nice border and prevent the bottom edge from rolling/curling.)

LAST STRIPE

Work the final blue stripe in garter stitch by knitting every row. Bind off.
