

Lecture Task Chair

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

KEEP ALL PACKAGING MATERIALS UNTIL YOU HAVE VERIFIED ALL COMPONENTS AND PARTS

1. Connect the top, circular plate of the leg base to the circular plate of the chair, found on the underside of the seat.
2. Rotate the plate of leg base so that the holes on both circular plates are aligned. Be sure that the arrow on plate of leg base is facing towards the front edge of seat as shown.
3. Use the bolts (A) to attach the base to the seat and tighten with Allen wrench (B).

To help maintain the appearance of the chair, we recommend frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime. Spot clean using foam only from a water-based cleaning agent such as a mild detergent or non-solvent upholstery shampoo. Apply foam with a soft rag or brush in a light circular motion. Vacuum when dry. Always pretest a small area before proceeding. The steel arms and legs can be cleaned with a soft damp cloth

DEPENDING ON USE, IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO TIGHTEN THE SCREWS PERIODICALLY TO MAXIMIZE THE STABILITY OF THE CHAIR.
