ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Remove all parts from carton and separate them into groups in preparation for assembly.
- B. To begin assembly, place base (2) upside down and insert casters (1) or feet (1B) into bottom of base (2).
- C. Turn base (2) right side up on the floor and insert gas lift (3) into center hole on base (2).
- D. Attach seat plate (4) onto the bottom of upholstered seat (5) (with front of seat plate facing front of seat cushion) by using 1" screws (6) for the holes of the seat plate (4) and tighten screws.
- E. Place the upholstered seat (5) with the seat plate (4) on top of gas lift (3) and press down until fully engaged.
- F. Periodically ensure that the screws are still fully tightened.

This chair has been tested and approved for normal use which is defined as a standard work week of forty hours by a person weighing less than 275lbs.
