KAREN RICHARDSON WATERCOLOUR STUDIO 2019 FALL WORKSHOPS - MATERIALS LIST

Recommended materials for students to bring:

- Arches watercolour paper, 300 lb, cold press, bright white in the following sizes:
 - o For Island Reflections, approx. 9 x 12"
 - o For Canoe and Mist, a 1/4 sheet (approx. 11 x 15")
 - o For **Rocky Shore**, approx. 8 x 10"
 - o For Driftwood Beach, a 1/2 sheet (approx. 15 x 22" or 16 x 20")
 - For students bringing their own supplies to Pebbles 1-2-3, approx. 8 x 10"
- One sheet of foamcore, coreplast, Masonite or heavy rigid cardboard a few inches larger than your
 watercolour paper. (Used as a support for the watercolour paper. If using foamcore or cardboard, waterproof
 one side of it with packing tape or adhesive shelf liner.)
- Artist Quality Watercolour Paints: (Winsor & Newton, MaimeriBlu, or other Artist quality brand)
 - For **all workshops**: Antwerp Blue, Aureolin or Transparent Yellow, and Permanent Alizarin Crimson (or any brilliant transparent blue, yellow, and red)
 - For Canoe and Mist also bring: Neutral Tint
- Watercolour Brushes:
 - o Flat, synthetic, ½ " wide
 - Flat, synthetic, 1" to 2" wide (not needed for Pebbles 1-2-3)
 - Two rounds with a good point, size 12 larger is fine if you have them. (Winsor & Newton Sceptre Gold II Sable/Synthetic and Robert Simmons Sapphire Sable/Synthetic brushes are excellent quality and price.)
 - Fine synthetic rigger brush or pen-and-ink type dip pen for applying masking fluid or watercolour
- Watercolour paint palette with deep paint wells and large flat areas for colour mixing (Karen uses a Robert E. Woods palette which comes with a lid.)
- Liquid frisket (recommend Pebeo Drawing Gum or Winsor & Newton Art Masking Fluid) Not required for Island Reflections or Pebbles 1-2-3.
- Small bar of soap in a container (for use with frisket). Not required for Pebbles 1-2-3.
- Frisket eraser. Not required for Pebbles 1-2-3.
- Sheet of graphite transfer paper (Not needed for Rocky Shore or Pebbles 1-2-3)
- Large water container for rinsing brushes (a 2-litre ice cream pail is perfect)
- Masking tape, 1" wide
- HB or 2B pencil
- Eraser (white plastic is fine)
- Ruler (12" or 16"). <u>Not</u> required for **Pebbles 1-2-3**.
- Large box of facial tissues (i.e. Kleenex), used to prop up your painting support at a comfortable angle
- Small scraps of watercolour paper for colour testing
- Cotton rags (old T-shirt pieces work well)
- Toothbrush with stiff bristles (for spattering paint or masking fluid, and for cleaning the palette)
