

HORSE STALLS





Traditional Stalls

Traditional stall frames are made with 2" x 2" 16 gauge square tubing. All vertical bars on fronts and dividers are made with 1" 14 gauge tubing at 3" spacing.

Stall fronts & dividers come in standard 10' and 12' lengths. Dividers are available in two styles: solid or vertical rail.


Stall doors roll on aluminum rollers for smooth, quiet opening and closing. They can be centered within the stall front or offset to one side depending on your needs. Drop down door is recessed into the rolling door. Horse-proof latch is mounted flush with the door.

Side feed doors come standard and give access into the stall for feeding and watering purposes. Feed door frames are made with $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{4}$ " square frame material and 1" 16 gauge vertical rails.

Stalls can be set up in rows as well as back-to-back using connectors and wall mounts.

Powder coated. Available in black, brown, red, green, or gray.







Horse Stall Filler Options

Traditional horse stalls are available with different filler options:

- Lumber: Everything will come pre-installed and ready to install in your barn. Lumber used in the stalls is 2" x 6" #1 T&G.
- Poly Kickboard: Can be customized with a logo or ranch brand which will be installed prior to delivery.
- Frame Only: Stalls will be delivered with just frame work. This allows you to install lumber or another filler of your choice.

Our poly kickboard can be customized with any brand or company logo. Made with high density polyethylene this product is built to last. Polyethylene is a great alternative to wood because it provides the same great durability while being corrosion resistant and easy to clean.






McNicholas Barn
