## Material



Yarn:	Rosy Green Wool - Lovely Merino Treat (100% softest organic Merino) 210 m (230 yds) per 100 g in colour Cornish Slate Yarn consumption may vary depending on individual yarn tension when knitting. The indicated gram quantities apply according to the gauge. The recommended amount of skeins includes additional yarn for an approx. 20 x 20 cm (8x8 in) swatch. You can find tips on this topic on knithow.link/gauge.
Needles:	3.5 mm (US 4) 40 cm (16 in) circular needle or double-pointed needles for working a small circumference in the round 3.5 mm (US 4) 80 cm (32 in) circular needle 4 mm (US 6) 80 cm (32 in) circular needle Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.
Other:	Removable stitch markers, stitch holders (or waste yarn), darning needle, waste yarn and crochet hook for provisional cast-on, spray water bottle for spray blocking
Gauge:	20 sts x 27 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4 in) over St St with 4 mm (US 6) needles <b>after blocking</b>

Designed with 101.5 – 116.5 cm (41.25 – 47.25 in) positive ease at bust circumference and 18.5 – 28.5 cm (8 – 12.5 in) positive ease at hip circumference.
