TOP NOTES	
CITRUSY OR FRUITY	GREEN OR FRESH
Blood orange - sweet, juicy and lively. Adds playfulness to any scent.	Pine needles - clean, soft pine forest aroma
<b>Bergamot*</b> - fresh floral-citrus with green undertones. Very uplifting.	Petitgrain - bitter and woody with citrus undertones. Used sparingly, it
Raspberry - very delicate. Gives a	Coriander seed* - fresh and uplifting, with a powdery almost soapy finish.
slight fruity jam-like backnote (but is not strong enough to create a raspberry-themed scent)	
Fresh lemon - clean, uplifting lemon peel aroma.	Cucumber - fresh, light and clean with watery tones. Works well with
FLORAL	florals and citrus.
Bitter almond - cherry blossom/ marzipan notes. Beautiful with fruity, spicy or light floral notes	Fresh cut grass - exactly like freshly mowed grass on a summers day. Not long-lasting but so lovely!
SPICY	* pair well with pretty much everything.
Black pepper - warm and woody with slight animalic backnotes, Blends especially well with sweet notes and florals.	-

MIDDLE NOTES	
CITRUSY OR FRUITY	SPICY
<b>Peach</b> - fresh and juicy, just like ripe peaches	Ginger - warm, clean and softly spicy
Pineapple - Juicy and sweet, just like fresh pineapple	Pink peppercorn* - sharp, clean and peppery with slight floral backnotes
FLORAL	Sage - cool, green and herbal with musk backnotes
Jasmine - sweet, heady floral. Blends well with everything	Cardamom - aromatic and clean, just like the freshly-grated spice
Rose* - soft powdery floral. Makes everything smell better!	WOODY
Lavender - clean, green, aromatic floral	Rosewood - (from leaf). A beautiful, powdery soft wood note with a deep rosy aroma
Ylang Ylang* - soft, musky oriental floral, similar scent to oriental lilies	Cedarwood Virginia - warm and dry with a familiar "pencil-shavings" tone
Geranium - a soft yet full-bodied, floral with green leafy accents	Patchouli heart* - clean, warm and airy. Like patchouli but less earthy
Orange blossom* - clean, green, floral with a delicate rounded orange blossom aroma	GREEN OR FRESH
Violet petals - clean, light, delicate and powdery	May chang (litsea) - fresh and aromatic with citrus overtones. Like lemongrass but softer.
SWEET	Juniperberry - green & aromatic, like a mountain-top pine forest
Coconut - rich, sweet, true coconut aroma	Cypress - fresh, green and softly woody

BASE NOTES	
GREEN	SWEET
Fir balsam - caramelised burnt sugar scent with green forest overtones. One of our favourites!	Cotton candy - soft, sweet, playful and long-lasting
<b>Labdanum</b> - green, sweet and earthy. Notes of the forest floor.	Vanilla* - deep, sweet and woody. More woody and not so candy-like
Oakmoss - damp, mossy and a little oceanic. Used in small doses.	Vanillin - sweet and powdery and candy-like
FLORAL	Amber accord* - sweet and earthy with a mossy undertone. (Note: does not pair well with citrus)
Violet leaf* - crushed violet leaves. Green floral. Great with florals and woods. A beautiful juxtaposition to sweet notes	Tonka bean - sweet, woody and caramel-ish with dry grass undertones. Used in small doses.
WOODY	MUSKY
<b>Tobacco</b> - smoky, earthy and sweet with slight green tones. Like pipe tobacco. Adds intrigue when used in small doses	Warm musk - smooth, warm and deep, and sweet. Like musk candy
Sandalwood Australian* - soft and understated clean, warm wood	Clean musk* - (ambrettolide) - clean, pale skin musk. Less sweet and lighter than our warm musk accord
<b>Vetiver</b> - smoky, woody, earthy and damp, like fresh-turned soil	SPICY OR AROMATIC
Patchouli - smoky and earthy	Frankincense - aromatic and light with an incense character and a lemon backnote
Guaiacwood - creamy and lightly smoky with slightly salty undertones
