#### **Summer 2021 Highlights**

The spring has brought new opportunities for growth and change for the survivors in our home, and a broader reach of our impact model as we expanded to include comprehensive mobile case management services and outreach in the community funded by our Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of Victims Crime (OVC) grant. We have received referrals from federal law enforcement, local providers, churches and much more. We continue to reflect on the progress that has been made, as well as the overwhelming need that remains. A special part of the PEHT home women's healing journey this spring has included the adoption of our first PEHT pet! A sweet tiger-striped cat named Luna who the women took in from the streets and made her part of the PEHT home. Luna has brought joy and love into our home.

We have had an active Winter and Spring program calendar with two monthly house celebrations, weekly crochet groups, equine therapy outings, weekly expressive art therapy, spoken word sessions, as well as weekly psychoeducational trauma-focused group meetings. Lastly, but not least, our social enterprise business is launching this June! We are in the exciting stage of offering the women we walk alongside employment, entrepreneurship opportunities such as product development, applying artistic talents to create new prototypes, and branding experiences. We look forward to showcasing with you, our new products: including survivor-created art renderings for pet accessories, dog leashes, bags, dog bowls and much more.








### **OUR IMPACT January - May 2021**

12+ survivors served through intensive mobile case management services






