WHAT IT IS?	Caviar Print is a technique where small beads are used to create the design on the fabric.	Discharge printing is the process of using water-based inks to bleach the original dye out of a shirt and replacing it with whatever dye color you choose.	Dye sublimation printing is a printing technique that involves applying a heat press to vaporize the ink and make the graphic. Avaliable full, hood, and or pocket locations	Foil printing is a specialty printing process which uses heat, pressure and metallic paper (foil).	Screen printing is a technique that involves using a woven mesh screen to support an inkblocking stencil to receive a desired image.	To create a glow-in- the-dark effect, a phosphorescent ink is printed atop a light reflecting white under base.
EXAMPLE:	A resort was giving out tshirts with a view of the beach, and they wanted to highlight the sand with the beads.	The company wanted to have a flat design that would not fade off of the shirt.	A school wanted to put a picture of the mascot on the hood & the logo for the school on the front of the sweatshirt	A jewelry vendor was giving out t-shirts and used this technique to emphasize the diamonds on the shirt.	A company had a design with many colors, screen printing can do multiple shades and inks.	A museum was giving out t-shirts for their Space event and used this to make the planets glow in the dark.

WHAT IT IS?	A photorealistic screen print is a technique that involves using multiple screens to create an image on a shirt.	Suede/Flock Screen Printing is where we apply color, adhesive and deposit many small fiber particles (called flock) or suede onto a t-shirt or apparel surface.	Gel Screen Printing adds a layer of "high density" gel on top of your screen- printed t-shirt or garment creating an amazing, decorative 3-D coating.	Embroidery is the craft of decorating fabric or other materials using a needle to apply thread or yarn.	High Color Embroidery is decorating your fabric or item with high color and high intensity thread.	This is the embroidery where a piece of the art or lettering puffs out above the rest. This is done by using 3-D Embroidery foam.
EXAMPLE:	A hospitality company wanted to put an image of their hotel on shirts to give out.	A furniture company used this technique to emphasize the design of their new couch.	A retail brand used this technique to accentuate their logo and make it 3-D.	A country club wanted a higher end decoration on the polo shirts they give out, so they used embroidery to print the logos onto the shirts.	A retail brand used high color embroidery to accentuate their new logo when they resigned it.	A Broadway Play used puff embroidery to emphasize the title of the play.
