



ALP PREMIER Prato Striped Poncho

Size: One Size Fits All



Yarn: 2 skeins Feza Alp Premier

ALP PREMIER #33

Needles: US #10 20" circular

Gauge: 16 sts x 16 rows - 4"
square in stockinette

Pattern Notes:

Poncho pieces are worked in multiple directions,
Piece A will be a rectangle

Piece B will become an "L" shape as it is knit to
Piece A to form one side of the poncho.

Piece C is knit on the bias and will be pulled into an
"L" shape with a "square" cut out of one corner when
assembled.

Piece C becomes one side of the poncho

The pieces will work with each other to form a
poncho whereby the cast off of Piece A and B form
the neckline one side of the poncho and the cast on of
Piece C forms the neckline on the other side of the
poncho.

Slip markers as you come to them unless otherwise
indicated.

Abbreviations:

BO - Bind Off

CO - Cast On

K - Knit

P - Purl

PM - Place Marker

Rep - Repeat

RS - Right Side

SM - Slip Marker

Sts - Stitches

YO - Yarn Over

WS - Wrong Side

Pattern:

Piece A:

CO 44 sts

Row 1-6: S1, knit to end of row

Row 7: S1, purl to end of row

Row 8: S1, knit to end of row

Rep rows 7 - 8 until piece measures 15"/ 38cm



BO all stitches



With RS facing, PM on the 18th stitch from the left, this marker will be used to join Piece A to Piece B as Piece B is knit.

Piece B:

Using long tail cast on, CO 18 sts

Row 1 (RS): S1, knit to second to last stitch at end of row knit the last stitch of this row to the 18th stitch of RS of Piece A - 18 sts

Row 2 (WS): With working yarn, pick up 17th stitch from end of Piece A knit it together with the first stitch of Piece B - 18 sts

Row 3-6: Rep rows 1-2 picking up one stitch at the end or beginning of Piece A and joining it with Piece B maintaining a constant number of 18 sts.

Row 7 (RS): S1, knit to end of row, pick up 12th stitch from end of Piece A knit it together with the last live stitch of Piece B - 18 sts

Row 8 (WS): Pick up 11th stitch from end of Piece A purl it together with the first live stitch of Piece B - 18 sts

Row 9-18: Rep rows 7 - 8

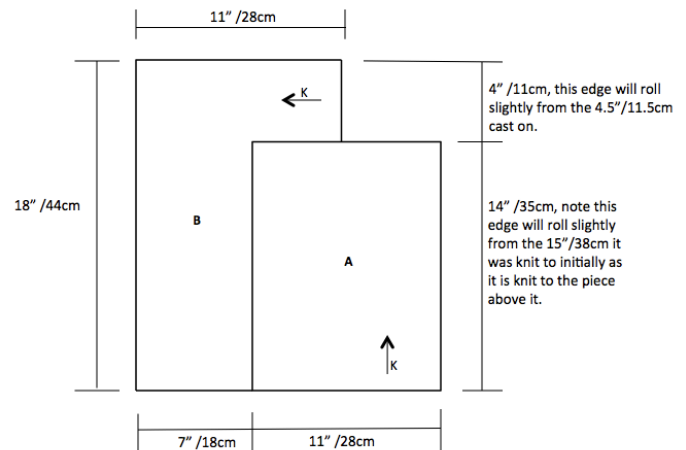
Row 19: S1, knit to end of row, pick up first stitch from end of Piece A knit it together with the last live stitch of Piece B, continue to knit across picking up a total of 56 stitches along the selvedge edge of Piece A. - 72 sts

Row 20: S1, purl

Row 21: S1, knit

Rep row 20-21

When work measures 11"/28cm from cast on 18 sts edge bind off all stitches.



Piece C:

CO 39 sts

Row 1 (RS): K19, pm, k1, pm, k19

Row 2-6: Knit

Row 7 (RS): S1, K to marker, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k to end (2 sts inc)

Row 8: S1, p to end

Row 9-12: Rep row 7-8

Row 13: S1, k to end

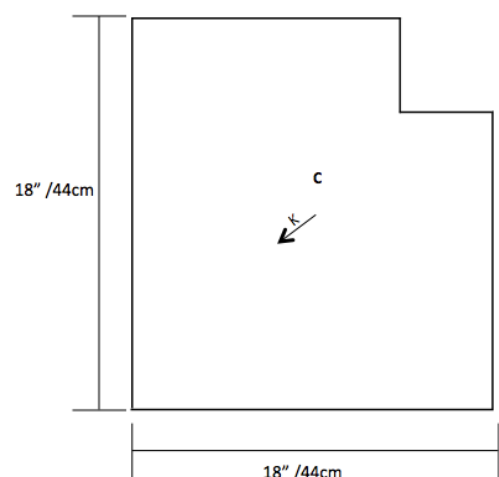
Row 14: S1, p to end

Row 15-62: Rep row 9-14

Row 63-66: Rep 7-8

Row 67-72: S1, k to end (85 sts)

Bind off all stitches



Finishing

With RS facing each other, join selvedge edge of C to selvedge edge of A

With RS facing each other, join selvedge edge of C to selvedge edge of B
