

## **Favorite Fringed Scarf**



## **Materials:**

Viva Glitz by Feza – 1 skein. For a different look, try 1 skein of Feza's Alp Premier or Alp Dazzle (pictured right).

## Cut Fringe before you start knitting.

You can put as much or as little fringe as you want on your scarf. For the Viva Glitz view (pictured left), cut 95 strands each 12" long, and make the tassels five strands each. The Alp Premier version has used 9" strands for fringe. When cutting fringe for Premier or Dazzle separate the different fibers and pick up strands from each fiber stack. This fiber combination will make a tassel. May want more than five strands for these tassels.

You will need: US#8 - 32" Circular Needle for Viv Glitz, US#10 - 32" Circular for Premier or Dazzle. Crochet Hook to Attach Fringe Cast on 3 stitches -- Knit 3 stitches

Rows 1 - 6: Cast on 3 sts at the beginning of each row, slip the first st and knit the row. Rows 7-12: Cast on 6 sts at the beginning of each row, slip the first st and knit the row. Rows 13-38\*\*: Add 8 sts at the beginning of each row, slip the first st and knit the row.

Bind off loosely.

Add the fringe. Five tassels in the center, one on each point and 4 tassels on each side of points. Can always add more or less fringe. Make it your own. Enjoy! \*\*Note: When using Premier or Dazzle knit to 34 rows for approx. 68" length . Designed by Pam Cipriani, Knit 'n Knacks, Canton, GA.
