



### **Saree Facts**

During the 2019 G20 summit in Osaka, Japan, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi gifted exquisite handloom sarees to the wives of world leaders as a gesture of cultural diplomacy, fostering international appreciation for India's textile heritage.

A team of skilled weavers from the Sambalpur District Handloom Weavers' Cooperative Society in Odisha, India, created the world's longest saree measuring an incredible 3.5 kilometres (2.17 miles). This monumental silk masterpiece took over 6 months to weave.
