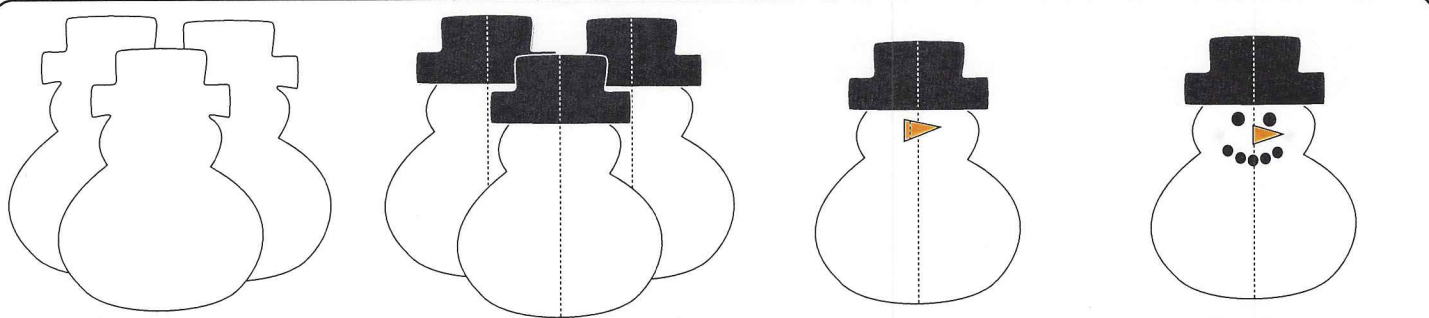
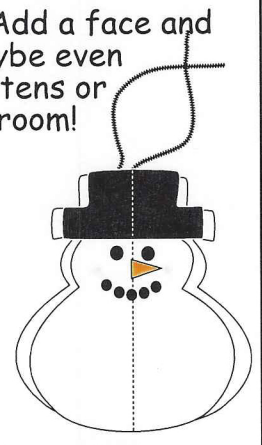
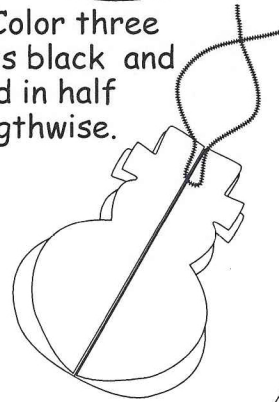
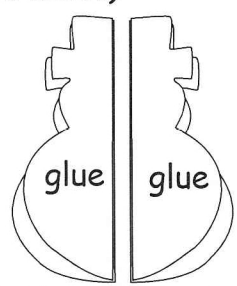


How to make 3-D Ornaments for Christmas & Winter



1. Choose three snowmen. (Any symmetrical shape will work!)
2. Color three hats black and fold in half lengthwise.
3. Cut a triangle for a carrot nose & glue in place.
4. Add a face and maybe even mittens or a broom!

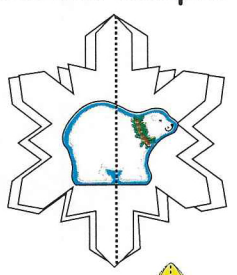


5. Glue the back sides of two folded pieces together. Match up sides & fold edges carefully.
6. Cut a 10" piece of yarn, fold in half & knot the top. Glue to the inside center of the ornament.
7. Glue the decorated face side on top. Adjust the folds and Voila' - 3-D snowmen!

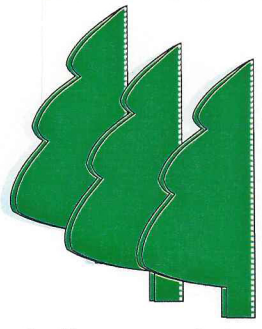


Variations:

Terrific Hands-On Lesson in Symmetrical Shapes



Symmetrical Paint & Fold Ornaments



1. Start with 3 symmetrical creative cut-out shapes. Pre-fold in half and unfold. Squirt blobs of paint or glitter glue on one side.
2. Press painted sides together gently and **unfold**. Repeat the process for all three sides, and let them dry.
3. Glue three pieces together as shown above. Add yarn, ribbon or raffia for a hanger.

Materials :

- 3 Creative Cut-Outs
- Glue Stick
- Glitter glue
- Markers
- Colored paper
- Yarn, raffia or ribbon

Optional:

- Wavy cut scissors
- Fancy shape hole punches
- Stickers
- Cotton balls, confetti
