
How To Print on Creative Shapes Etc. Notepads by Creative Shapes Etc.

Here is a fun way to display student writing samples. Great for poetry, word cards, and flash cards of all kinds. Use for math facts, spelling words, vocabulary words and more! Organize flash cards by hole punching and add a metal ring. Laminate for permanence. Create your own write and wipe activities. Use YOUR imagination!

1. Print a document on 8 1/2" x 11" paper. (It might take some experimenting to get the font to fit.)

> A tiny frog hops out, then jumps in for a swim. Gee its hard to catch him! Pollywog, pollywog, is now a slippery leap frog!


2. Tape on a sheet of a notepad. Use a good brand of tape, so it will be easy to peel off later.



3. Hold it up to the light and center it. Feed it through the printer so the tape edge feeds in first.



4. The ink prints on the top layer of paper! Carefully pull off the tape... Voila'!



Helpful Hint: Quick alignment idea for multiple copies... Center the sheet over words, trace around shape lightly in pencil.
