ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING!

Be sure electrical power is OFF before and during installation or maintenance.

The luminaire must be installed by a qualified electrician, in accordance with all applicable local codes.

Ensure that the rated luminaire voltage requirements are compatible with the available mains supply in which it will be installed.

All LEDS are included in your lamp. Never touch the LED surface with your bear hands as this may reduce the life of your LED.

Do not alter, relocate or remove any electrical component.

Material: Natural Wood Venner, MDF and carbon steel.


Turn off the power before beginning the installation, and keep it off until the installation is complete.

This assembly process requires the assistance of two people to be completed successfully.

- 1 Remove the protective packaging from the components, taking care not to damage any parts with sharp surfaces or objects.
- ② Insert the steel cable into the adjustable cable clamps installed on the canopy. To insert the cable and adjust the height, press the tip of the clamp while simultaneously inserting the cable. Upon releasing the tip, the clamp will lock and secure the component. Adjust all the clamps and steel cables, setting the desired height and leveling the fixture. After adjustment, neatly coil any excess cables and ensure they do not come into contact with electrical connections.
- (3) Insert the power cable into the strain relief (S), nipple (N), and junction box cover (JB). Adjust the cable length to match the desired height at which the fixture will be installed.
- (4) Make the electrical connections in accordance with all applicable safety regulations and electrical installation codes. This product must be installed in compliance with the relevant technical standards and by someone familiar with electrical installations, the product itself, and aware of the associated risks.
- (5) Using the screws (S1) provided, secure the mounting bar to the junction box.
- 6 Attach the nipple to the mounting bar through the central hole of the canopy. Bring the canopy and cable gland close to the junction box, then tighten the cable gland onto the nipple, securely fastening the canopy to the ceiling. Once the connection is secure, tighten the screw on the cable gland to anchor the power cable.
- (7) Install an E-12 compatible bulb into the E-12 socket, with a maximum rating of 8W.

Turn on the electrical power.
