

Reuss Repeater

The Reuss Repeater is an exact clone of the vintage 1960s Vox Repeat Percussion effect with an added clean boost to serve as a level control. It's a hard, percussive, almost strobe-light kind of a tremolo which also adds a synth-like texture to the sound.

Controls

- 'RATE' sets the speed of the effect. Turning the knob clockwise makes the rate go faster
- 'LEVEL' sets the output level. The original repeat percussion circuit does not have a level control, so this is a separate clean boost circuit added in series to the output of the original circuit. By nature it is a 'crackle okay'-control which makes a noise when adjusted. It's the price you pay for the strong, clean sound of this circuit

Footswitch

- Switches the effect on and off, indicated by the orange LED (mechanical true bypass)

Connectors

- 'IN' is the input of the pedal. Connect your instrument here
- 'OUT' is the output. Connect your amp here
- The 9V DC connector is for a standard guitar pedal 'negative centre'-type jack. ONLY use this type. Reversing the polarity can damage the pedal. The pedal can also run on a 9V battery (not included)

Please note: The unit is drawing power from the battery, when there is a jack in the input connector. Always remove the input jack when the pedal is not in use, if you are running it with a battery

Specifications

- Vintage 1960s Repeat Percussion circuit built with the correct 'tin can'-transistors (new, expensive European made lead-free versions)
- Extremely high build quality. Completely handmade in the European Union
- No SMD parts. Only vintage-style 'through hole' construction
- Compact aluminium enclosure with a silver metallic powder coat finish and UV printed decal
- High quality Neutrik jacks, wired by hand
- Upgrade quality footswitch (good for at least 15000 stomps)
- Runs on a standard 'Boss-style' 9V DC guitar pedal power supply or a 9V battery
- Power consumption 10 mA



Battery access

- Remove the four screws at the bottom side of the pedal with a philips head screw-driver to remove the bottom plate and gain access to the battery

Warranty

- All Reuss pedals comes with a limited 24 months warranty against manufacturing faults
- The warranty is not covering normal wear and tear or abuse
