Saftey Instructions

When using your Prestige A3+ Printer for DTF, basic precautions should always be followed.

- 1. Read all instructions.
- 2. Use the Prestige A3+ Printer only for its intended use.
- 3. To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not immerse the DTF printer in water or other liquids.
- 4. Do not disassemble or attempt to repair the DTF printer without qualified guidance. Please contact support for technical assistance.
- 5. The equipment is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of this equipment by a person repsonsible for their safety.
- 6. Close supervision is necessary for any DTF printer being used by or near children. Do not leave equipment unattended while connected.
- 7. The Prestige A3+ printer needs routine maintenance, please refer to the this manual.




Operations Instructions


1. Connect the Prestige A3+ Printer for DTF to power




2. Turn on the system




3. Paper rolling test.




4. Install waste ink bottle.




5. Place the waste ink plates under the printer.



6. Fill the ink reservoirs.



7. Pull the inks into the ink cartridges.



8. Pull ink into the waste ink bottle.

- 8.1 Remove the ink waste tube from the ink waste bottle and withdraw waste ink with the injector by pulling the injector plunger.
- 8.2 re-insert the waste ink tube into the waste ink bottle





9. Head to Software Installation.
