



2013 La Pitchoune Chenoweth Chardonnay

A light yellow color introduces stone fruit aromas of nectarines and apricots, amplified by a sprinkle of fresh grated nutmeg. Flavors of dried apricot, baked pear, and Meyer lemon curd mingle with roasted nuts and coalesce with a minerality that provokes a lengthy finish. Designed to age, this wine should provide an extraordinary drinking experience over the next 5-8 years.
