

2014 La Pitchoune Chardonnay Chenoweth Vineyard - Russian River Valley

A light yellow-green color introduces creamy aromas that are amplified with orange blossom, and stone fruits. Flavors of dried apricot, baked pear, and Meyer lemon curd mingle with roasted nuts and coalesce with a minerality that provokes a lengthy finish. So fun to drink now, but expect this wine to drastically improve with another 6 to 12 months in the cellar. Designed to age, this wine should provide an extraordinary drinking experience over the next 5-8 years.
