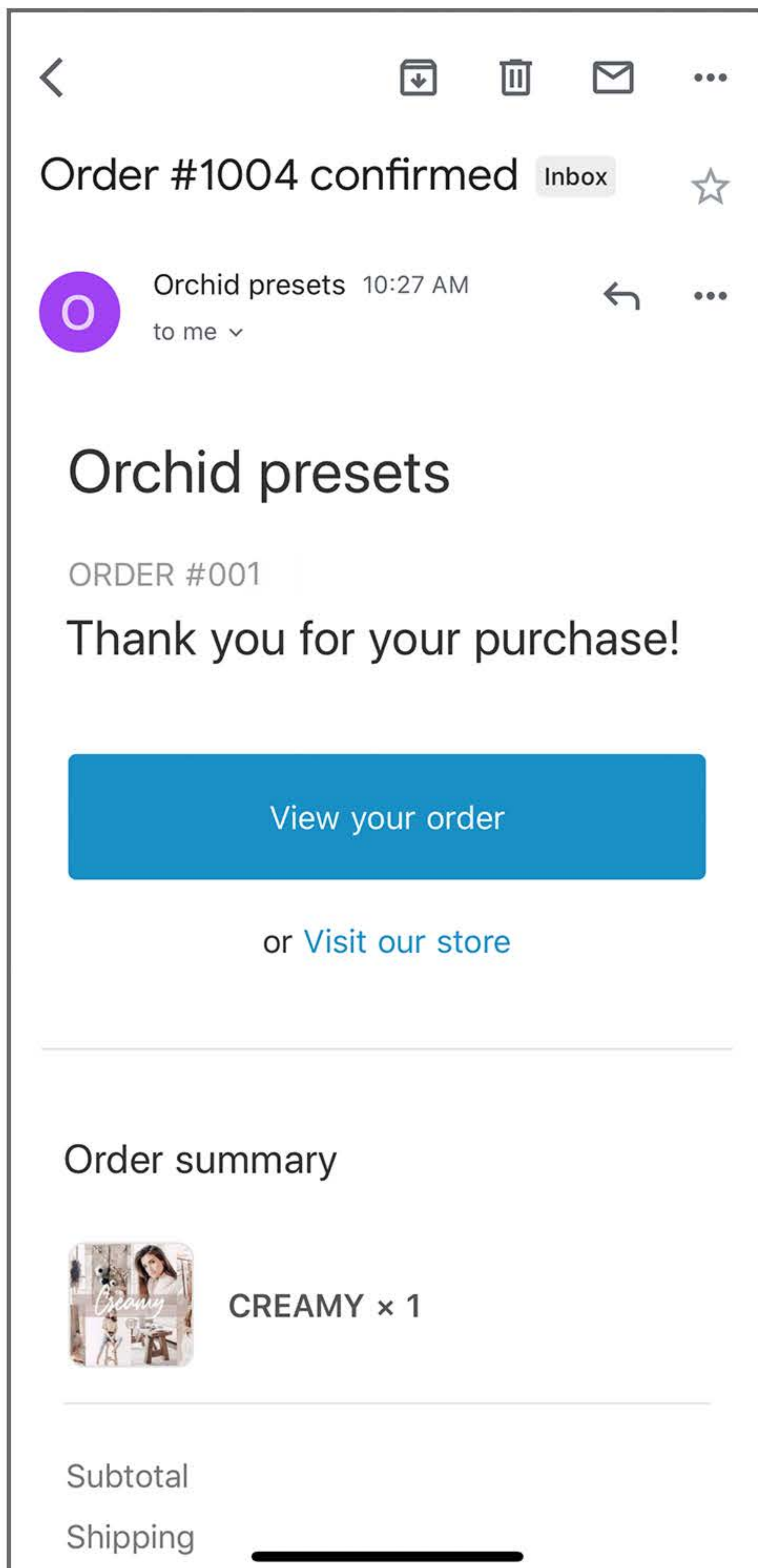
1.GETTING YOUR PHONE SET

Adobe lightroom cc App is a FREE App & you will need to download it to use our presets.

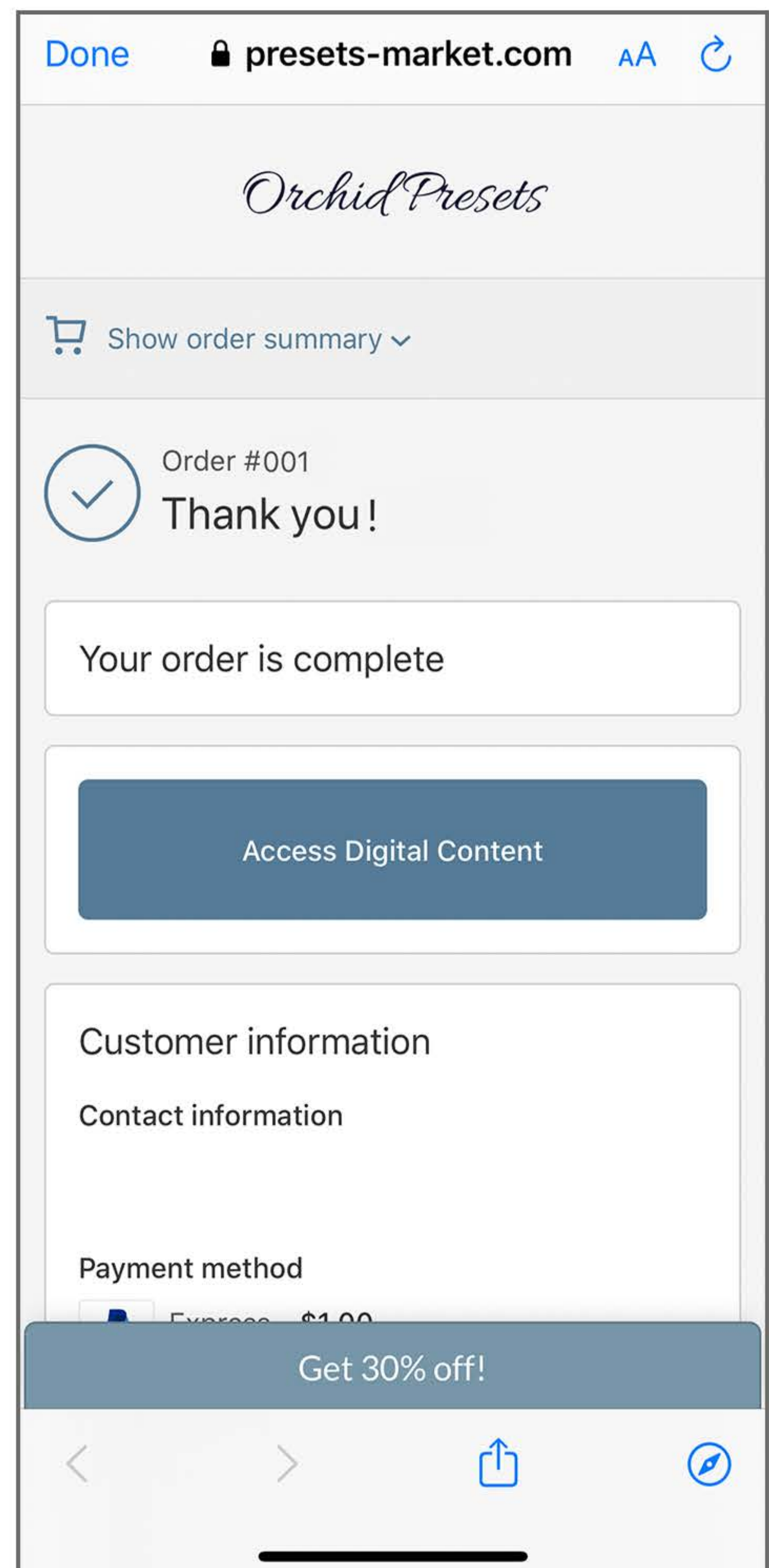


Download the Lightroom cc App
from the App store.

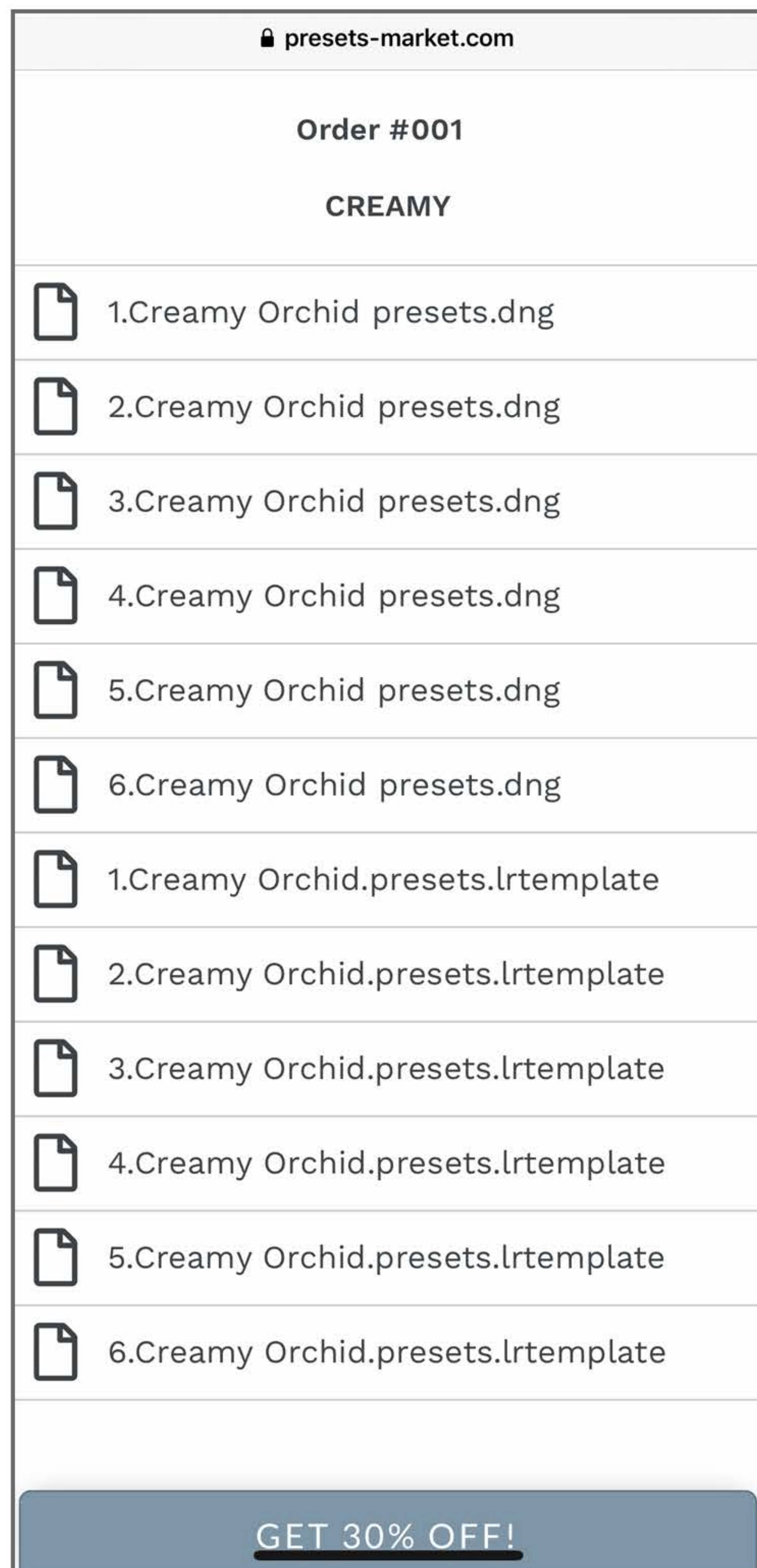
2.DOWNLOADING YOUR DNG FILES



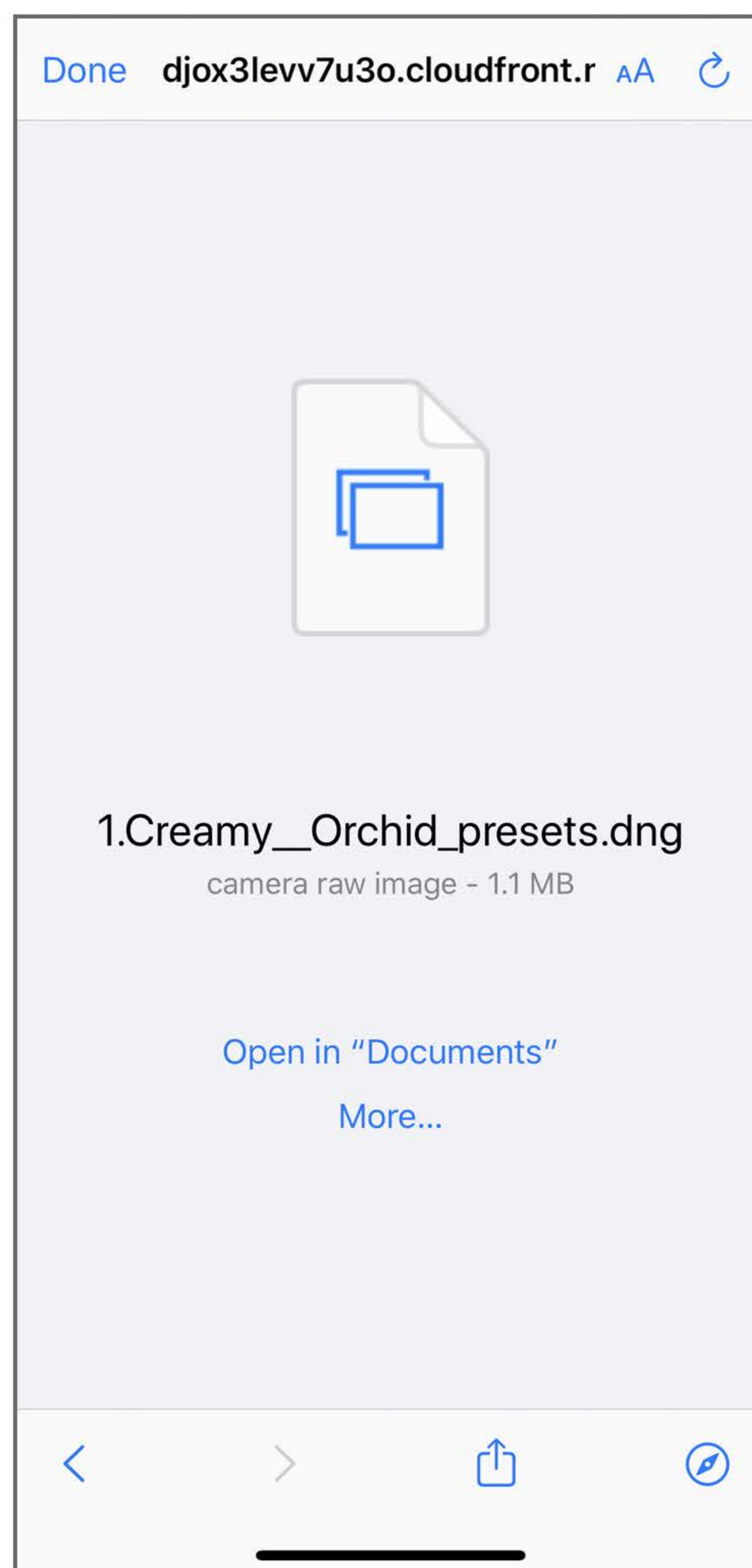
After you complete your purchase you'll receive an E-mail to view your order



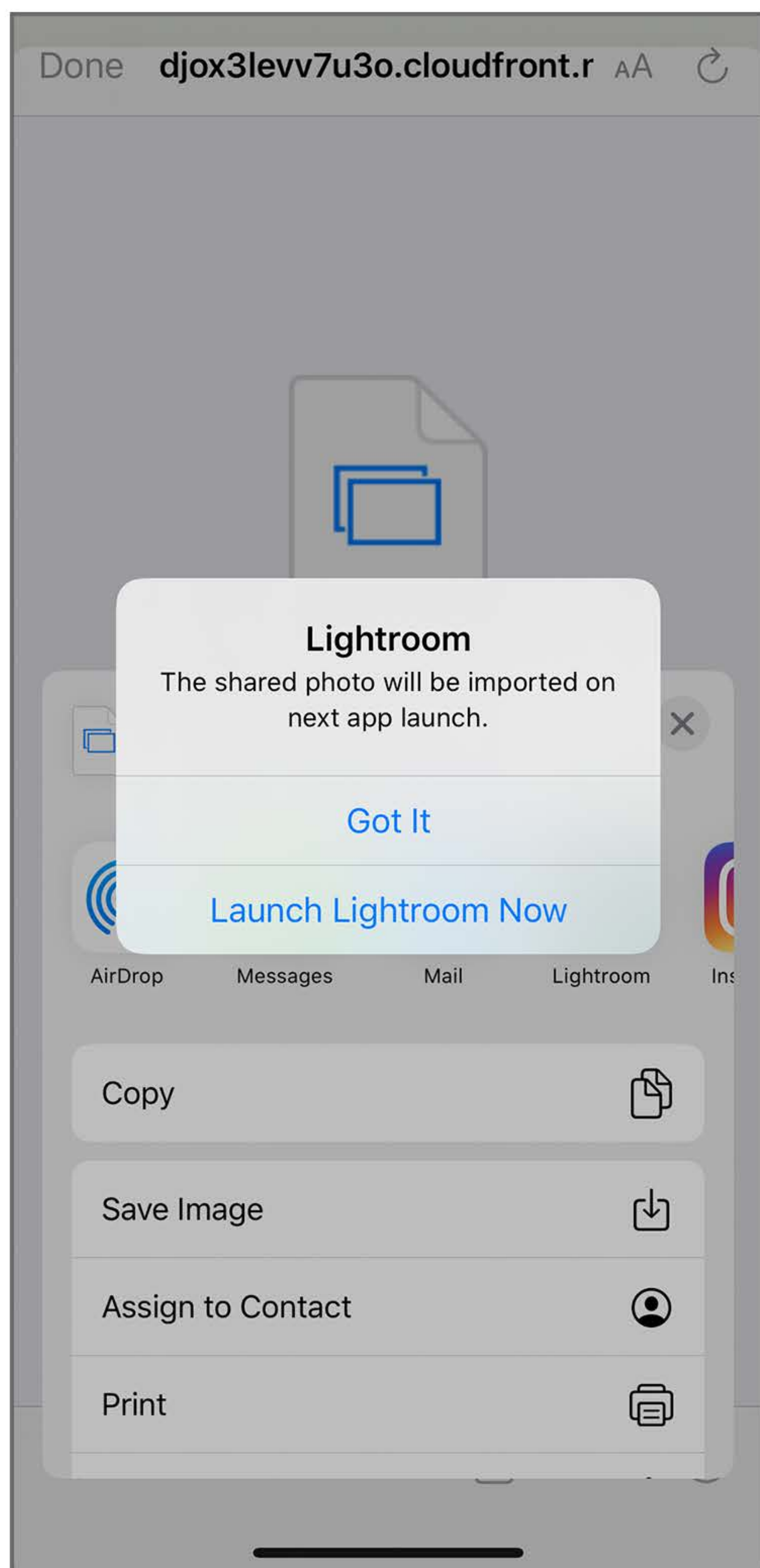
Press
“Access Digital Content”



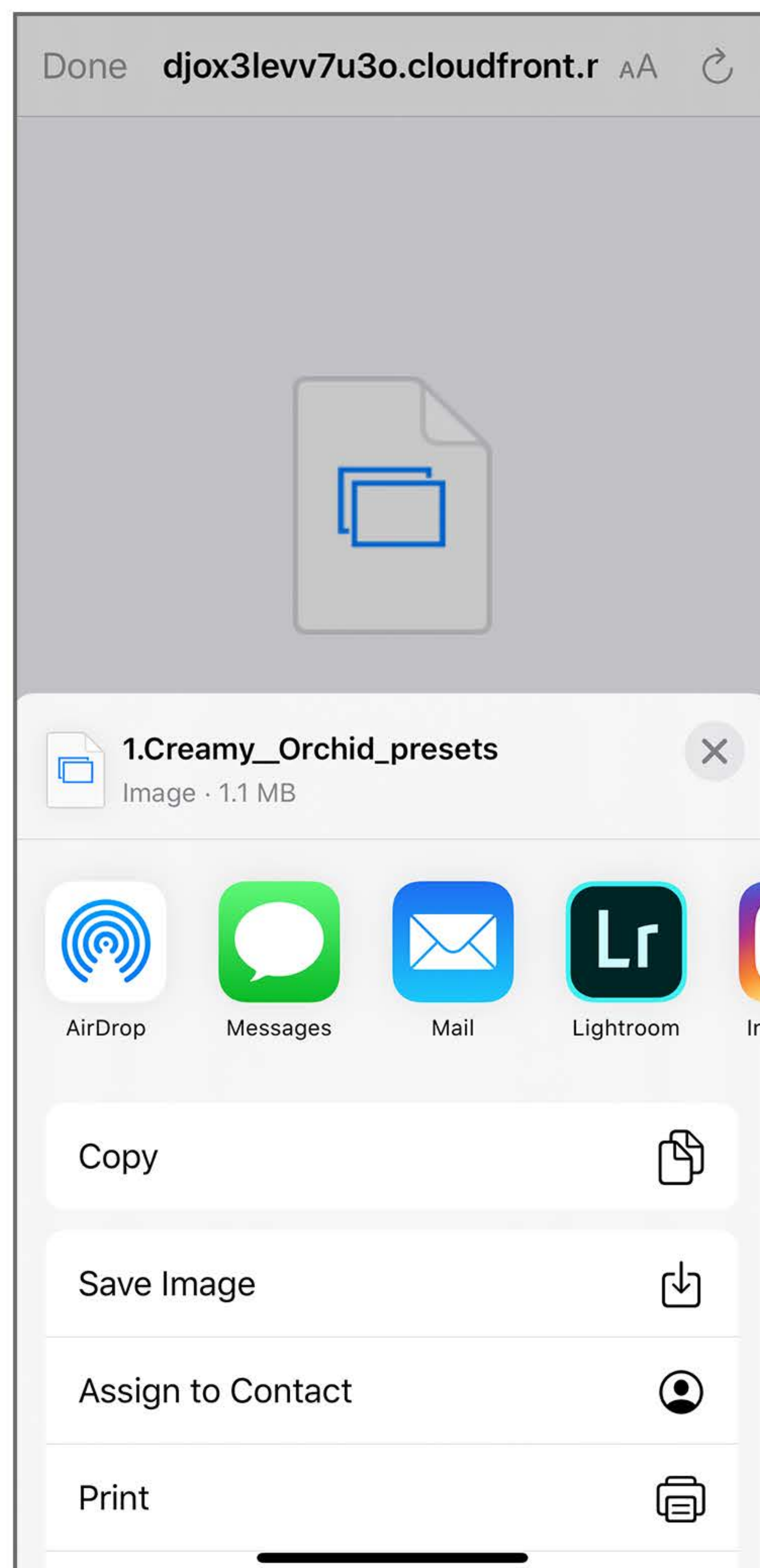
Click on the DNG file
to download



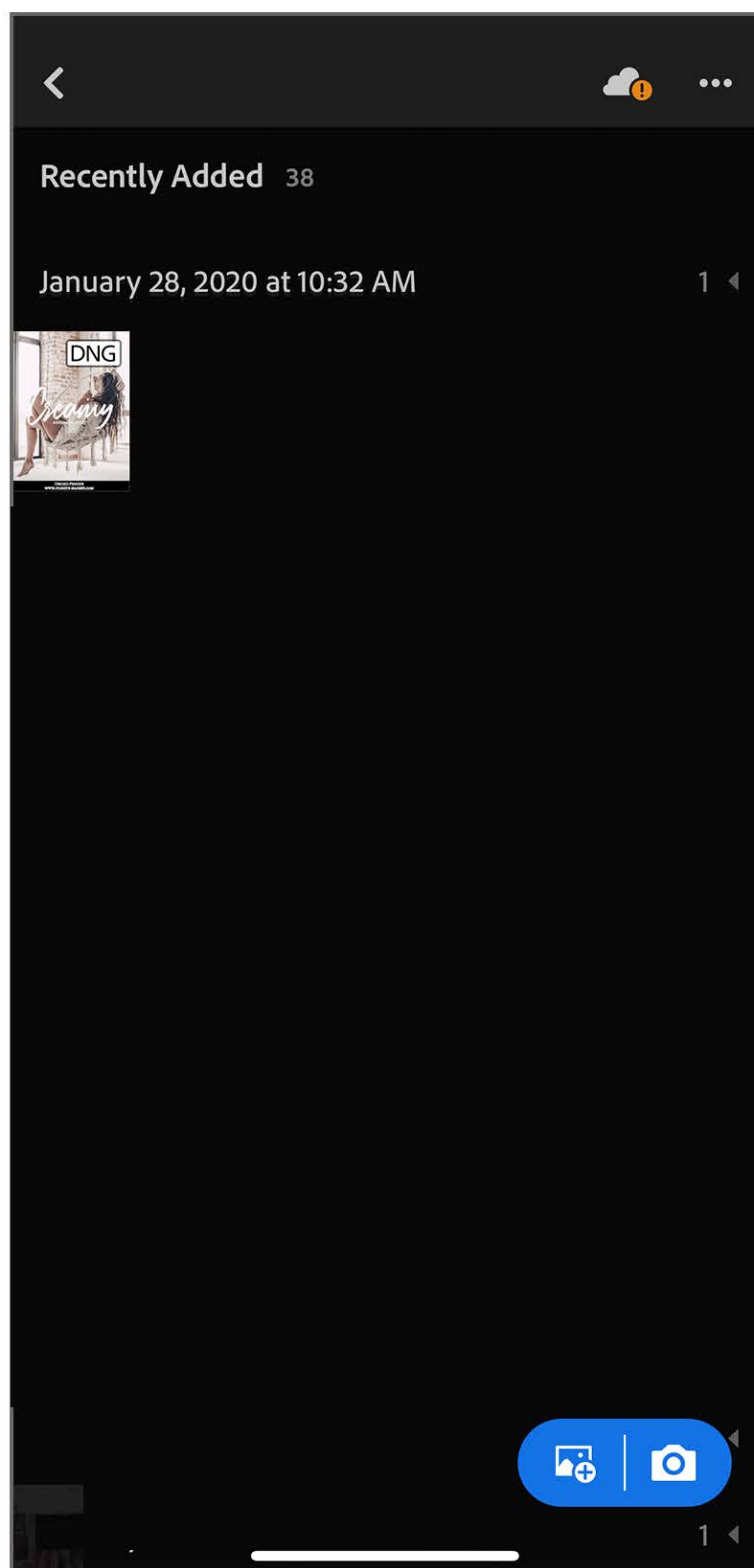
A link will be opened.
Click "More"



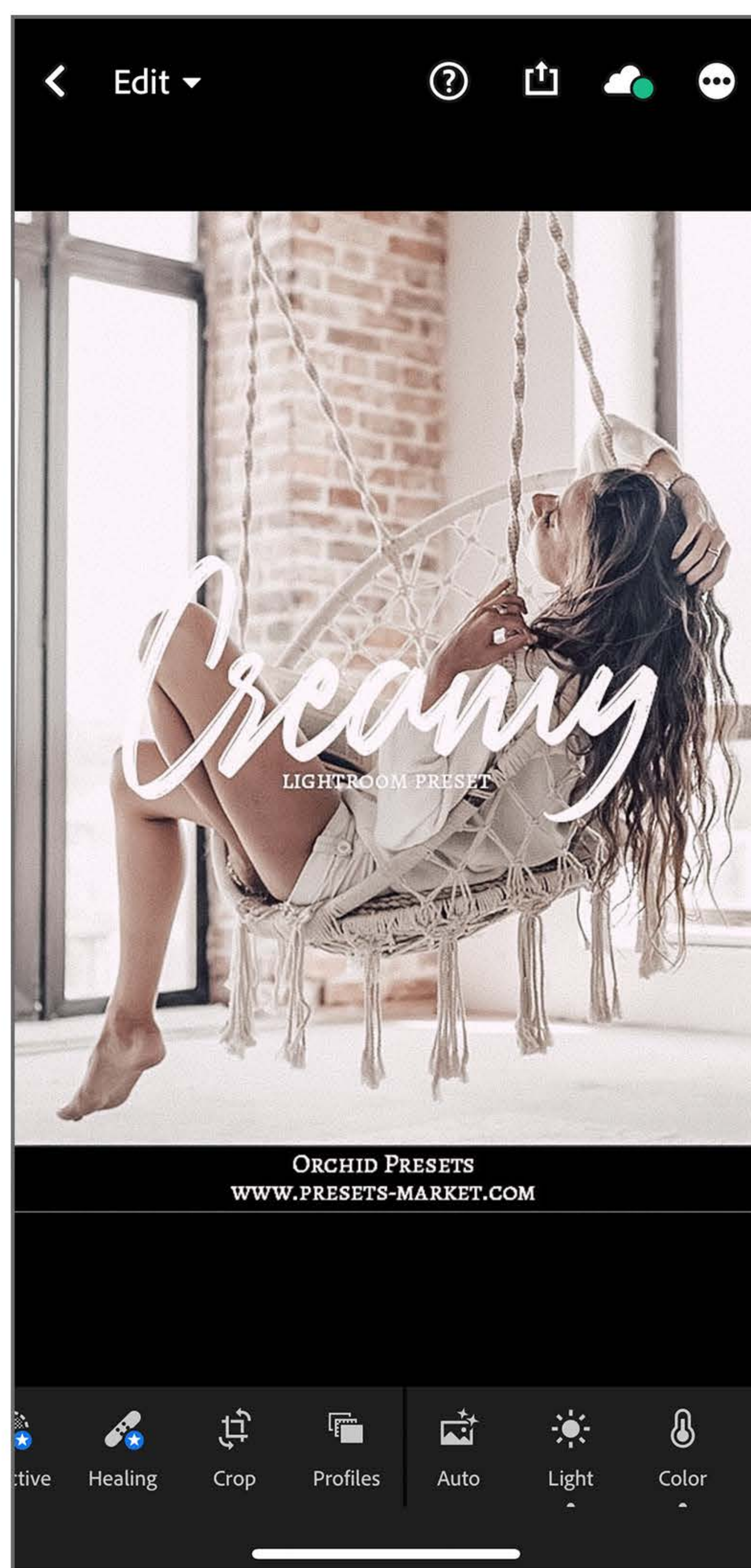
Click
“Launch Lightroom Now”



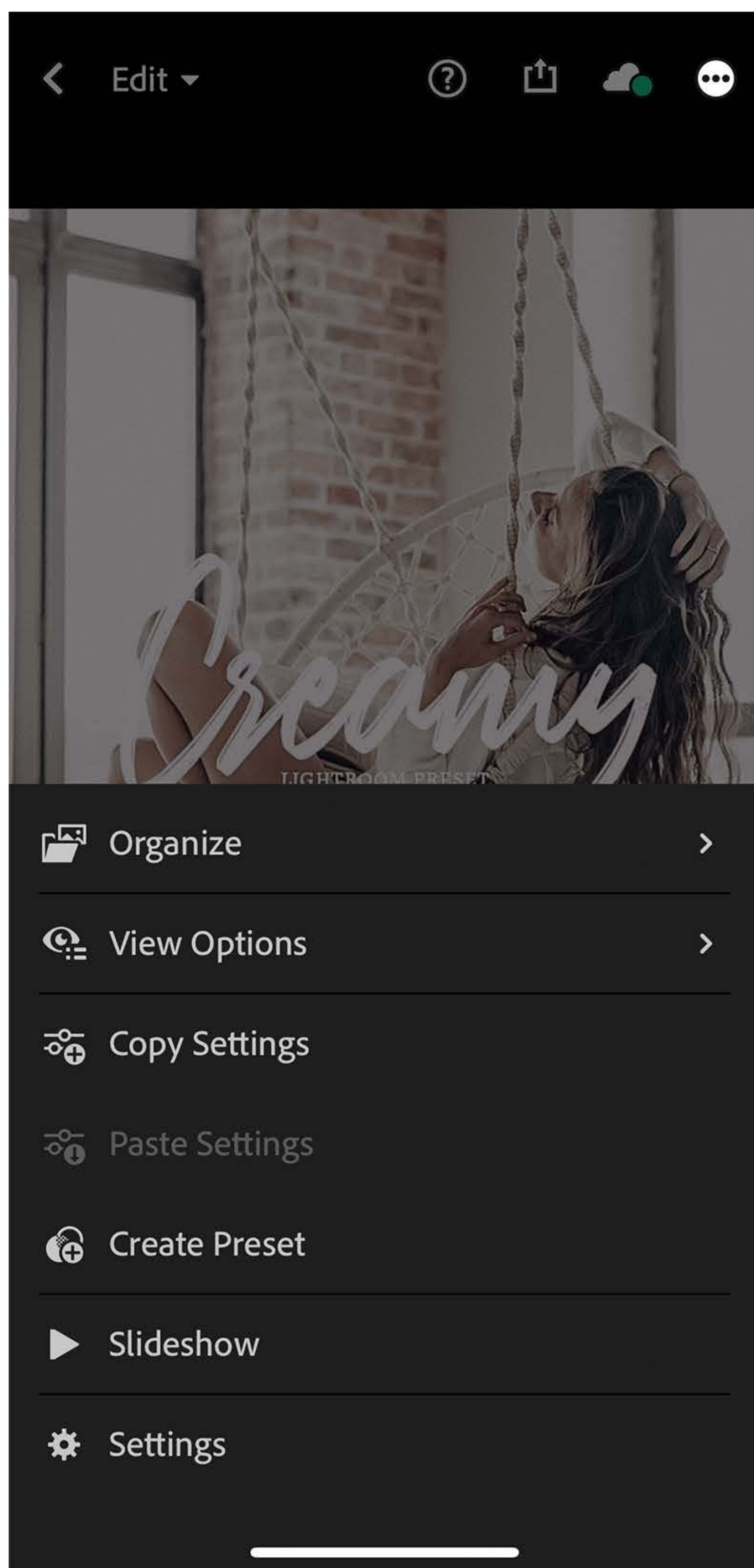
Select “Lightroom”



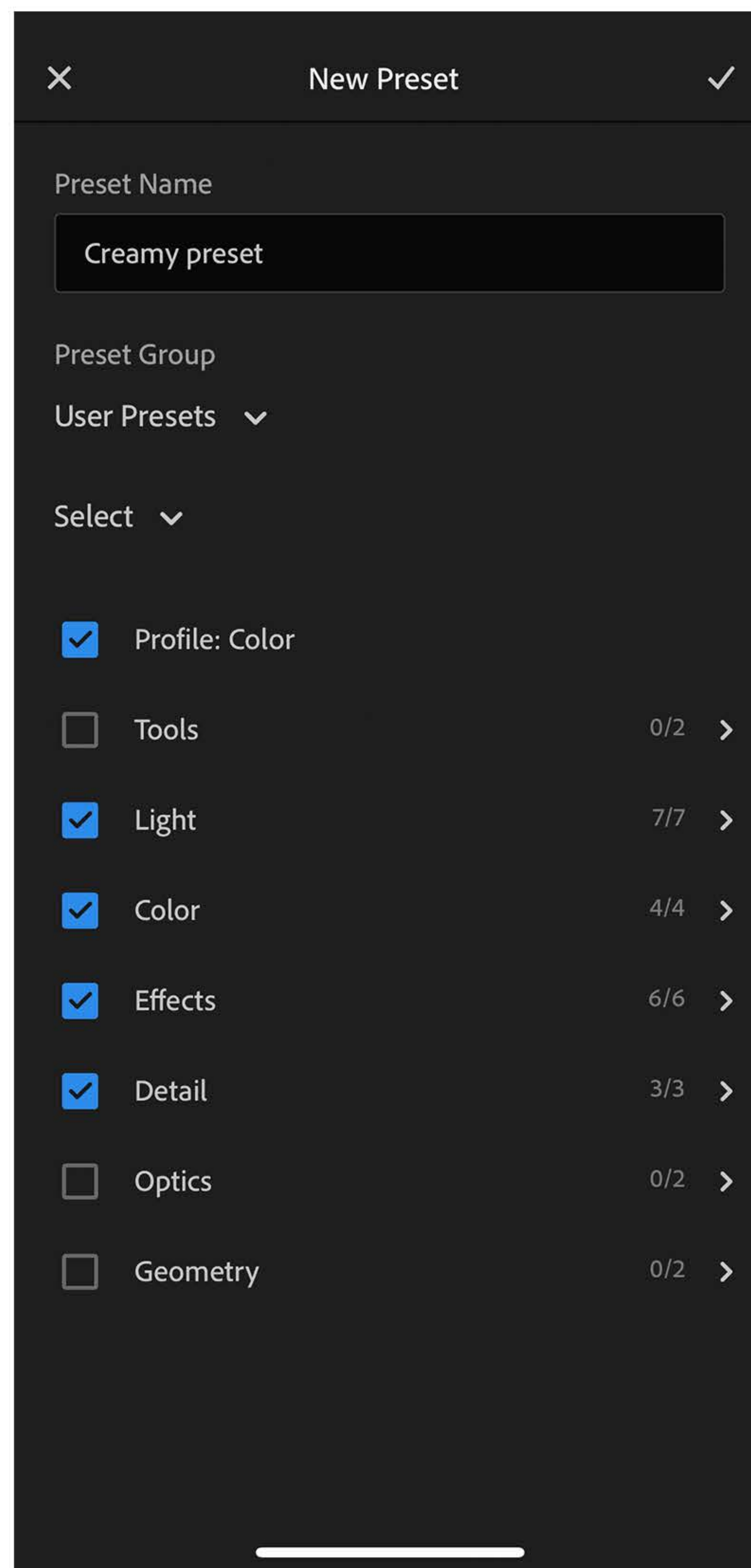
Select the DNG

button on the top right



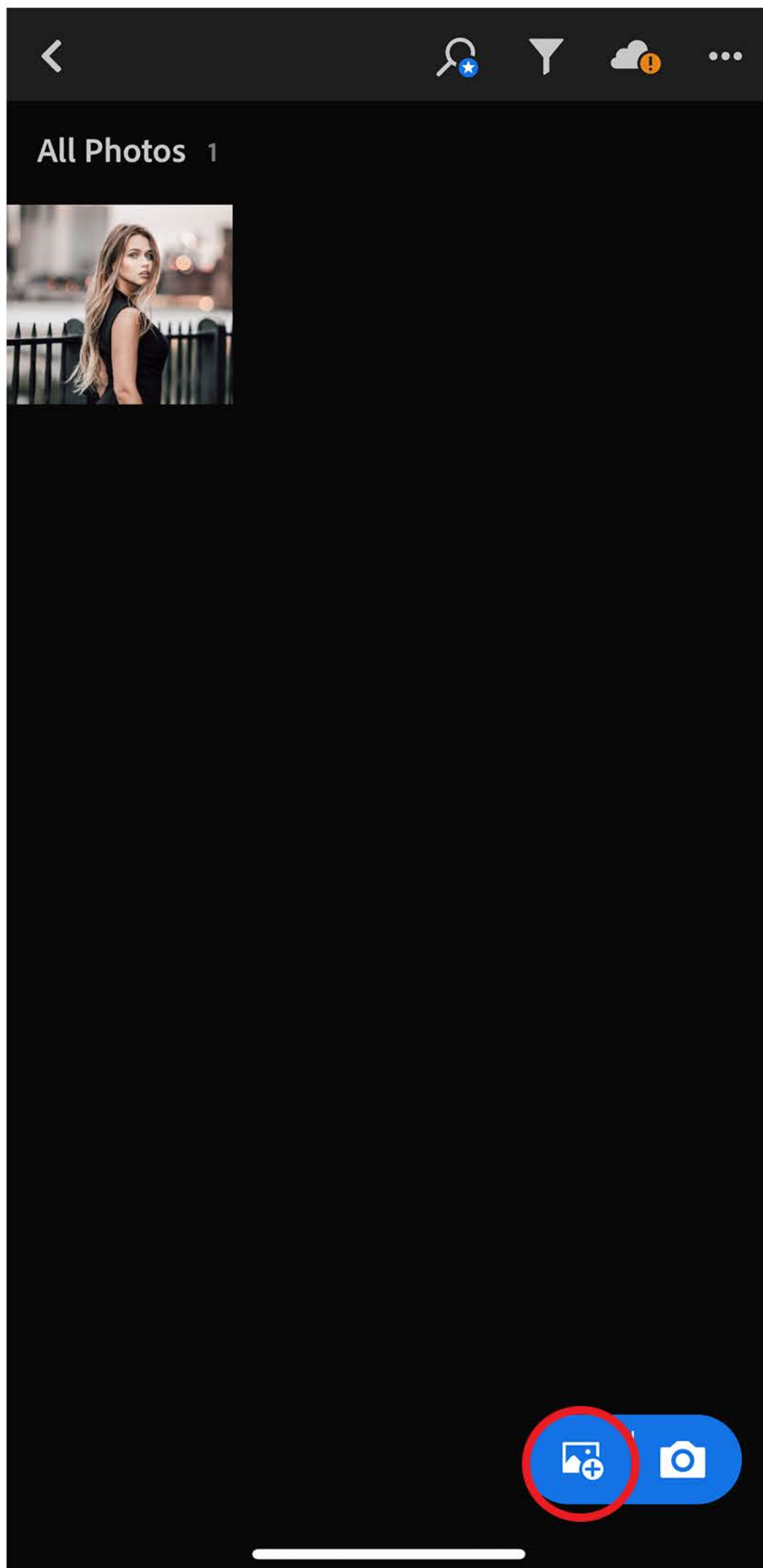
Choose “Create preset”



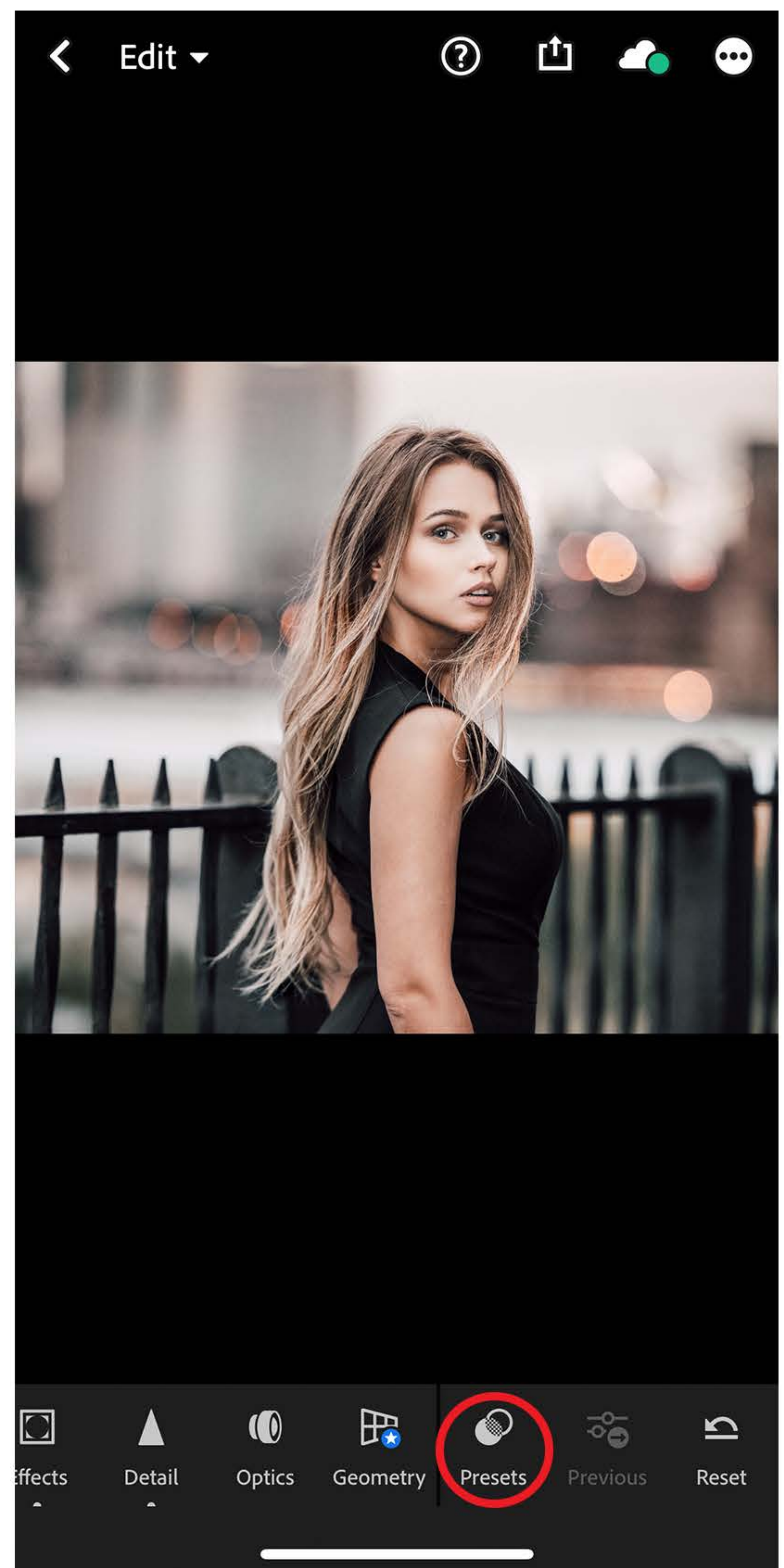
Enter a name for the preset

Note: you need to repeat these steps for each DNG file.
After that, your presets will be added permanently to the Lightroom app
and you'll edit your photos directly.

3.IMPORTING PHOTOS TO EDIT



By pressing the plus button you can import the photos you want to edit



You will find all the saved presets by clicking on the “presets” button. Categorized under “user presets”

NOTES

-All of our presets have been tested on a variety of different images and with just one click you will get an amazing perfect look.

-In some cases a little adjustments will be needed after applying the preset to your image to achieve the desired look, as every photo is different due to the camera's performance, white balance, lighting, background colors and others.

-You can adjust the white balance Temp if you want a warmer or cooler picture. Or change the light options if you want a darker or brighter image. It's too easy to find them and adjust in Lightroom.
