There is no need to bring the music we emailed to you; your own printed music will be waiting for you to collect when you arrive.

Please don't panic if the music we send you looks a bit tricky, or if there are things you don't understand; there will be plenty of players on each part, so you won't be on your own. Do a bit of practice on any bits that need it, and we will give you lots of help on the day.

If you feel that some of your music is quite easy, we know you will understand that the less advanced players will really appreciate your support, and hopefully some of the others pieces will challenge you!

If you have been sent an alto flute or bass flute part but don't have an instrument (or have never played one), just have a go at it on your own flute for now; during the workshop you will have plenty of help to make friends with these wonderful flutes. We will also provide any extra percussion or sound effects listed on your music.
