DOWNLOAD THE CBP ROAM APP!

Search "CBP ROAM" in the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and download the app



 Open the CBP ROAM app and enable location services



SIGN INTO CBP ROAM VIA LOGIN.GOV

- Click "Log In or Sign Up" and accept the terms. The app will redirect to login.gov, where you can either create or access your existing account
- You must have a login.gov account to use the CBP ROAM app on a personal device





DO NOT HAVE a login.gov account? Tap "Create an account" and follow the instructions

ALREADY HAVE a login.gov account? Sian in to your account, and you will be redirected back to the ROAM app

ADD AND SAVE PROFILES

Traveler Profile

- In the CBP ROAM app, tap the "Travelers" section and provide required information
- Save the profile for future use
- Repeat this process for each traveler on the trip



Mode of Travel Profile

- Select "Modes of Travel"
- Add a mode of travel and provide required information
- Save the profile for future use

Accept the terms and sign into CBP ROAM using your login.gov account



Select "Create Trip"



Select the passengers and mode of travel (saved in profile) on trip. Click "Add Traveler" or "Add Mode of Travel" to add new profiles



Designate a master of the vessel from the list of passenger profiles and input their phone number



Answer all trip detail and declaration questions



Submit the trip



A CBP Officer will review your submission and may initiate a video chat if necessary



A copy of the final notification will be sent to the email address provided



Streamlined reporting process with reusable traveler and mode of travel profiles using login.gov

Shorter wait times by reporting from a smart device instead of calling in

Remote inspections by CBP Officers using video chat as necessary
