# STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

alt - alternate

#### **BACK**

Using 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>mm needles and thumb method cast on 174 [194:210:226: 238:258] sts.

Ist Row. \* K2, p2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**2nd Row.** P2 \* k2, p2, rep from \* to end.

Ist and 2nd rows set 2x2 rib.

Work in 2x2 rib for I2cm, (4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>in), ending with a rs row.

Next Row. P2 [9:10:11:10:13], p2tog, (p6 [5:5:5:6:5], p2tog) 21 [25:27:29: 27:33] times, p2 [8:9:10:10:12]. 152 [168:182:196:210:224] sts.

Change to 31/4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

Ist Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

Ist and 2nd rows set st-st (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until back measures 28 [28:28:29: 30:31]cm, (II [II:II:II½:II¾:I2]in), ending with a ws row.

### SHAPE ARMHOLES

Cast off 3 [3:4:4:5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 146 [162:174:188:200:214] sts.

For 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Next Row. K4, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 6 sts, k2tog, k4. [160:172:186: 198:212] sts.

Next Row. P4, p2tog, purl to last 6 sts, p2togtbl, p4. [158:170:184:196:210] sts. Work [0:0:2:2:4] rows dec [0:0:1:1:1] st at each end as before in every row. [158:170:180:192:202] sts.

For all 6 sizes

Next Row. K4, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 6 sts, k2tog, k4. 144 [156:168:178: 190:200] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

every foll 4th row.

Last 2 rows set armhole shapings. Work 2 [2:4:4:20:22] rows dec I st at each end as before in next and every foll 0 [0:2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd] row.

142 [154:164:174:170:178] sts. \*\*
Work 17 [17:21:29:13:13] rows dec
I st at each end as before in next and

132 [144:152:158:162:170] sts.
Cont without shaping until armholes measure 22 [24:26:27:28:29]cm,
(8<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> [9<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>:10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:10<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:11:11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>]in), ending with a ws row.

# **SHAPE SHOULDERS**

Cast off 4 [5:6:6:6:7] sts at beg of next 2 [6:6:6:6:6] rows. 124 [114:116:122: 126:128] sts.

For 1st size only

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 4 rows. 104 sts.

# For all 6 sizes DIVIDE FOR NECK

Next Row. Cast off 5 [5:6:6:7:7] sts (shoulder edge), k18 [21:21:23:24:25], turn, leave rem 80 [87:88:92:94:95] sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 19 [22:22:24:

25:26] sts only proceed as follows:-

**Next Row.** P2tog (neck edge), purl to end. **18** [21:21:23:24:25] sts.

**Next Row.** Cast off **5** [6:6:6:7:7] sts, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog.

12 [14:14:16:16:17] sts.

**Next Row.** P2tog (neck edge), purl to end. II [13:13:15:15] sts.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:6:7:7:7] sts, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Cast off rem 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts.

With rs facing, working on rem 80 [87: 88:92:94:95] sts, rejoin yarn and cast off 56 [60:60:62:62:62] sts, knit to end. 24 [27:28:30:32:33] sts.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [5:6:6:7:7] sts (shoulder edge), purl to last 2 sts, p2tog (neck edge).

18 [21:21:23:24:25] sts.

Next Row. K2tog, knit to end. 17 [20:20:22:23:24] sts.

Next Row. K2tog, knit to end. 10 [12:12:14:15] sts.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:6:7:7:7] sts, purl to end. 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

Cast off rem 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts.

# **FRONT**

Work as given for Back to \*\*.

Work 12 [16:18:20:6:6] rows dec

I st at each end as before in next and every foll 4th row.

136 [146:154:164:166:174] sts.

# **DIVIDE FOR NECK**

Next Row. (K4, s1, k1, psso) 1 [1:0:1: 0:0] times, k56 [61:71:70:77:81], k2tog, k4, turn, leave rem 68 [73:77:82: 83:87] sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 66 [71:76:80: 82:86] sts only proceed as follows:-Next Row. P4, p2tog, purl to end. 65 [70:75:79:81:85] sts.

For 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Work 4 [6:8:5:5] rows dec I st at armhole edge as before in 3rd [Ist:3rd: Ist:1st] and foll 0 [0:4th:4th:4th] row AT SAMETIME dec I st at neck edge as before in every row.

60 [68:69:74:78] sts.

For 2nd, 5th and 6th sizes only Work [8:5:5] rows dec I st at neck edge only as before in every row. [62:69:73] sts.

For all 6 sizes

Work 51 [47:51:49:45:45] rows dec I st at neck edge only as before in

next and every foll alt row. 34 [38:42: 44:46:50] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 22 [24:26:27:28:29]cm,  $(8\frac{3}{4} [9\frac{1}{2}:10\frac{1}{4}:10\frac{3}{4}:11:11\frac{1}{2}]in)$ , ending with a ws row.

### **SHAPE SHOULDER**

Next Row. Cast off 4 [5:6:6:6:7] sts, knit to end. 30 [33:36:38:40:43] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [5:6:6:6:7] sts, knit to end. 25 [28:30:32:34:36] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [5:6:6:6:7] sts, knit to end. 20 [23:24:26:28:29] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [5:6:6:7:7] sts, knit to end. 15 [18:18:20:21:22] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:6:6:7:7] sts, knit to end. 10 [12:12:14:14:15] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:6:7:7:7] sts, knit to end. 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Cast off rem 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts.

With rs facing, working on rem 68 [73: 77:82:83:87] sts, rejoin yarn and k4, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 6 [6:0:6:0:0] sts, (k2tog, k4) | [1:

0:1:0:0] times (armhole edge). 66 [71:76:80:82:86].

**Next Row.** Purl to last 6 sts, p2togtbl, p4. 65 [70:75:79:81:85] sts.

# For 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Work 4 [6:8:5:5] rows dec I st at neck edge as before in every row AT SAME TIME dec I st at armhole edge as before in 3rd [Ist:3rd:Ist:Ist] and foll 0 [0:4th:4th:4th] row. 60 [68:69:74:78] sts.

For 2nd, 5th and 6th sizes only Work [8:5:5] rows dec I st at neck edge only as before in every row. [62:69:73] sts.

### For all 6 sizes

Work 51 [47:51:49:45:45] rows dec I st at neck edge only as before in next and every foll alt row. 34 [38:42: 44:46:50] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 22 [24:26:27:28:29]cm,

 $(8\frac{3}{4} [9\frac{1}{2}:10\frac{1}{4}:10\frac{3}{4}:11:11\frac{1}{2}]$ in), ending with a rs row.

# **SHAPE SHOULDER**

**Next Row.** Cast off 4 [5:6:6:6:7] sts, purl to end. 30 [33:36:38:40:43] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

**Next Row.** Cast off **5** [5:6:6:6:7] sts, purl to end. **25** [28:30:32:34:36] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [5:6:6:6:7] sts, purl to end. 20 [23:24:26:28:29] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [5:6:6:7:7] sts, purl to end. 15 [18:18:20:21:22] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:6:6:7:7] sts, purl to end. 10 [12:12:14:14:15] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:6:7:7:7] sts,

purl to end. 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

Cast off rem 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts.

# SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 2<sup>3</sup>/4mm needles and thumb method cast on 102 [106:110:110:118:118] sts.

Work in 2x2 rib for 12cm,  $(4^{3}/4in)$ , ending with a rs row.

Next Row. P6 [7:9:10:7:6], p2tog, (p6 [5:5:6:4:6], p2tog) | | [13:13:11: 17:13] times, p6 [6:8:10:7:6]. 90 [92:96:98:100:104] sts.

Change to 31/4mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 6th [6th:4th:4th:4th:4th] row to 98 [116:108:118:132:142] sts.

Inc I st at each end of every foll 8th [8th:6th:6th:6th:6th] row to II8 [124:134:140:146:152] sts.

Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 45 [45:46:47:47]cm, (173/4 [173/4:18:181/2:181/2:181/2]in), ending with a ws row.

# SHAPE SLEEVE TOP

Cast off 3 [3:4:4:5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. II2 [II8:126:132:136:142] sts. Work I2 [I6:18:16:18:20] rows dec I st at each end of every row. 88 [86:90:100:100:102] sts. Work I8 [I6:16:20:20:18] rows dec I st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 70 [70:74:80:80:84] sts.









Work 12 [12:12:14:14:16] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 46 [46:50:52:52:52] sts.

Cast off 8 [8:10:10:10:10] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 30 [30:30:32:32:32] sts.

Cast off rem 30 [30:30:32:32:32] sts.

### **NECKBAND**

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing using 23/4mm needles, or 23/4mm circular needle if required, pick up and knit 76 [76:76:78:78:78] sts evenly along left side of neck, pick up loop at centre of V and knit into the back of this loop, pick up and knit 76 [76:76:78:78:78] sts evenly along right side of neck, 3 sts evenly along right side of back neck, 54 [62:62:66:66:66] sts evenly from 56 [60:60:62:62:62] cast off sts at back of neck and 3 sts evenly along left side of back neck. 213 [221:221:229:229:229] sts.

Ist Row. (P2, k2) 33 [35:35:37: 37:37] times, p2 [2:2:1:1:1], k1 [1:1:0:0:0], insert needle purlways through back of 2nd st then 1st st and slip both sts off needle tog, purl next st then pass 2 slipped sts tog over purl st, k1 [1:1:0:0:0], p2 [2:2:1:1:1], (k2, p2) 18 [18:18:19:19:19] times. 211 [219: 219:227:227:227] sts.

2nd Row. (K2, p2) 18 [18:18:19: 19:19] times, k2 [2:2:0:0:0], insert needle knitways into 2nd st then 1st st and slip both sts off needle tog, knit next st then pass 2 slipped sts tog over knit st, k2 [2:2:0:0:0], (p2, k2)33 [35: 35:37:37:37] times.
209 [217:217:225:225:225] sts.

Work 18 rows more in rib dec 2 sts in centre of V as before in every row.

173 [181:181:189:189:189] sts.

Cast off in rib dec 2 sts as before at centre of V.

### TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder and neckband seams. Fold sleeves in half lengthways then placing folds to shoulder seams, sew sleeves in position. Join side and sleeve seams. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
