





- C 16 [16:17:17:18] cm (61/4 [61/4:61/2:61/2:7]")
- D 13 [13:13:13] cm (5¼ [5¼:5¼:5½:5½]")
- E 7 [7:7:7:8] cm (23/4 [23/4:23/4:3]")
- F 17 [17:18:18:18] cm (6½ [6½:7:7:7]")
- G 28 [30:32:34:36] cm (11 [11%:12½:13½:14]")
- H 26 [26:28:28:29] cm (10¼ [10¼:11:11:11½]")
- 3 [3:3:3:3] cm (11/4 [11/4:11/4:11/4]")





STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

alt - alternate

beg - beginning

cm - centimetres

MI - pick up loop between last and next stitch and knit into back of this loop.

TIPS & TECHNIQUES

Work chart from right to left on right side rows and left to right on wrong side rows.

BACK

Using 3¹/₄mm needles and thumb method cast on 83 [85:89:93:97] sts.

Ist Row. * KI, pI, rep from * to last st, kI.

2nd Row. PI, * kI, pI, rep from * to end.

Ist and 2nd rows set IxI rib.

Work 3 rows more in 1x1 rib.

6th Row. P2 [3:5:6:2], p2tog, (p5 [5:5: 4:4], p2tog) | | [11:11:13:15] times, p2 [3:5:7:3]. 71 [73:77:79:81] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

Ist Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

1st and 2nd rows set

st-st (stocking stitch). **

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until back measures 38 [40:42: 44:46]cm, (15 [15³/₄:16¹/₂:17¹/₄:18]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE SHOULDERS

Cast off 10 [11:12:13] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 51 [51:53:55:55] sts.

Cast off 11 [11:12:13:13] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 29 sts.

Leave rem 29 sts on a stitch holder.

FRONT

Work as given for Back to **. Working in st-st (throughout) cont until front measures 15.5 [16.5: 17.5:18.5:19.5]cm, $(6\frac{1}{4})[6\frac{1}{2}:6\frac{3}{4}:$ $7\frac{1}{4}$: $7\frac{3}{4}$]in), ending with a rs row. Next Row. P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, p2tog. 69 [71:75:77:79] sts. Ist Row. K18 [19:21:22:23], work across 33 sts of chart, k18 [19:21:22:23]. 2nd Row. P18 [19:21:22:23], work across 33 sts of chart, p18 [19:21:22:23]. Keeping continuity of chart and st-st, work from 3rd to 40th row of chart. Next Row. KI, mI, knit to last st, mI, kl.71 [73:77:79:81] sts. Cont until front measures 32 [34:36: 38:39]cm, ($12\frac{1}{2}$ [$13\frac{1}{2}:14:15:15\frac{1}{2}$]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE NECK

Next Row. K26 [27:29:30:31], turn, leave rem 45 [46:48:49:50] sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 26 [27:29:30:31] sts only, proceed as follows:-

Next Row. P2tog, purl to end. 25 [26:28:29:30] sts.

Work 2 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 23 [24:26:27:28] sts.

Work 3 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll alt row.

21 [22:24:25:26] sts.

Cont without shaping until front measures 38 [40:42:44:46]cm, (15 [15 3 /4:16 1 /2:17 1 /4:18]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE SHOULDER

Next Row. Cast off 10 [11:12:12:13] sts, knit to end. 11 [11:12:13:13] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Cast off rem. 11 [11:12:13:13] sts.

Cast off rem [1 [11:12:13:13] sts.
With rs facing, working on rem 45 [46: 48:49:50] sts, slip 19 sts onto a stitch

holder, rejoin yarn to rem 26 [27:29: 30:31] sts and knit to end.

Next Row. Purl to last 2 sts, p2tog.
25 [26:28:29:30] sts.

Work 2 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 23 [24:26:27:28] sts.

Work 3 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll alt row.
21 [22:24:25:26] sts.

Cont without shaping until front measures 38 [40:42:44:46]cm,
(15 [15³/₄:16¹/₂:17¹/₄:18]in), ending with a rs row.

SHAPE SHOULDER

Next Row. Cast off 10 [11:12:13:13] sts, purl to end. [1 [11:12:13:13] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

Cast off rem [1 [11:12:13:13] sts.

SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 31/4mm needles and thumb

method cast on 45 [45:47:47:47] sts, work 5 rows in 1x1 rib. 6th Row. PI [1:2:2:2], p2tog, (p6, p2tog) 5 times, p2 [2:3:3:3]. 39 [39:41:41:41] sts. Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-Ist Row. Purl. 2nd Row. * KI, pI, rep from * to last st, k1. 1st and 2nd rows set patt. Working in patt (throughout) inc I st at each end of 3rd and every foll 6th row to 49 [43:55:49:53] sts, working inc sts in patt. Inc I st at each end of every foll 8th row to 59 [59:65:65:67] sts, working inc sts in patt. Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 28 [30:32:34:36]cm, $(11 [11^{3}/4:12^{1}/2:13^{1}/2:14]in)$, ending with a ws row.

SHAPE SLEEVE TOP

Cast off 4 [4:5:5:5] sts in patt at beg of next 2 [2:6:6:4] rows.
51 [51:35:35:47] sts.
Cast off 5 [5:6:6:6] sts in patt at beg of next 8 [8:4:4:6] rows. 11 sts.
Cast off rem 11 sts in patt.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, using 3½mm needles pick up and knit 18 [18:18:18:20] sts evenly along left

side of neck, work across 19 sts left on a stitch holder at front of neck as follows:- k4, m1, (k5, m1) twice, k5, pick up and knit 18 [18:18: 18:20] sts evenly along right side of neck and work across 29 sts left on a stitch holder at back of neck as follows:- k5, m1, (k4, m1) 5 times, k4. 93 [93:93:97] sts. Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work 6 rows.

Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder and neckband seams. Fold sleeves in half lengthways then placing folds to shoulder seams, sew sleeves in position for approximately 16 [16:17:17:18]cm, (6¹/₄ [6¹/₄:6¹/₂: 6½:7]in) from shoulder. Join side and sleeve seams. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.










