





- 31 [33:35:36:37:38] cm, (12 [13:13%:14:14½:15]")

# STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

A - shade A

B - shade B

beg - beginning

cm - centimetres

cont - continue

dec - decrease(ing)

foll - following

g - grammes

in - inch(es)

inc - increase(ing)

k - knit

m I - pick up loop between last and next stitch and knit into the back of this loop

mm - millimetres

patt - pattern

psso - pass slipped stitch over

rem - remain(ing)

sI - slip I stitch knitways

st(s) - stitch(es)

tog - together

ws - wrong side

0 - no rows

# BACK AND FRONT (Both alike)

Using 3½mm needles, thumb method and A, cast on 69 [73:77: 79:81:83] sts.

Ist Row. Knit.

This row will now be referred to as **g-st** (garter stitch).

Work 5 rows more in g-st.

Change to 4mm needles.

Ist Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Work 2 [4:6:6:6:8] rows more.

Next Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

67 [71:75:77:79:81] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Last 2 rows set side edge decs.

Work 12 [12:6:16:20:20] rows dec I st at each end as before in 5th [5th:0:7th:7th:9th] and every foll 6th [6th:0:8th:8th:10th] row. 63 [67:75:73:75:77] sts.

## For 3rd size only

Work 8 rows dec I st at each end as before in next and foll 6th row. [71] sts.

#### For all 6 sizes

Change to B.

Work 35 [35:35:30:43:41] rows dec I st at each end as before in 5th [5th:5th:7th:3rd:9th] and every foll 6th [6th:6th:8th:8th:8th] row. 51 [55:59:67:63:67] sts.

### For 4th size only

Work 13 rows dec 1 st at each end as before in next and every foll 6th row. [61] sts.

#### For all 6 sizes

Cont without shaping until work measures 22 [23:24:28:29:30]cm,  $(8^{3}/4 [9:9^{1}/2:11:11^{1}/2:11^{3}/4]in)$ , ending with a ws row.

### **SHAPE RAGLAN**

Cast off 3 [3:4:4:5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

45 [49:51:53:53:57] sts.

For 5th and 6th sizes only

**Next Row.** K3, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3. [51:55] sts.

Next Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Next Row. Knit.

Next Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Work [8:12] rows more dec I st at each end as before in next and every foll 4th row. [47:49] sts.

### For all 6 sizes

**Ist Row.** K3, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

43 [47:49:51:45:47] sts.

2nd Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2. Ist and 2nd rows set raglan shapings with g-st edging patt. Working in patt as set (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Work 9 [11:11:31] rows in patt dec 1 st at each end as before in next and every foll 2nd [2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd:0] row. 33 [35:37:39:41:45] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

## SHAPE YOKE FACING

Next Row. Knit. Next Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2. IN

5

CM

Next Row. K2, m1, knit to last 2 sts, m1, k2. 35 [37:39:41:43:47] sts.

Next Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts,

Last 2 rows set yoke shaping.
Work 4 rows more inc 1 st at each end as before in next and foll
2nd [2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd:0] row.
39 [41:43:45:47:49] sts.
Cast off rem 39 [41:43:45:
47:49] sts in patt.

## TO MAKE UP

Join side seams. Fold yoke facing to inside along g-st ridge and slip stitch in place to form casing for ties. Using three strands of A, make 2 twisted cords approximately 46 [48:50:52:54:60]cm, (18 [19: 19<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>:21<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:23<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>]in) in length for the shoulder ties. Thread ties through casings and knot at shoulders. Work 2 rows of running stitch and embroider flowers using lazy daisy stitch, using B below line of colour change and A above. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
