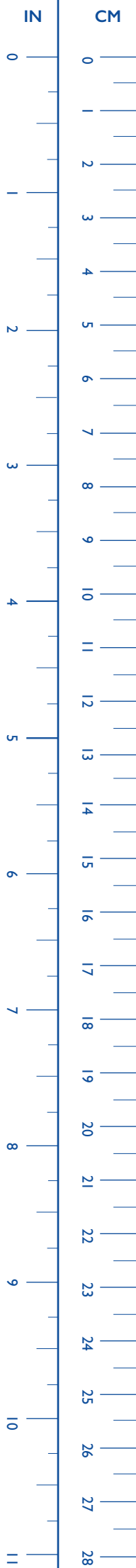

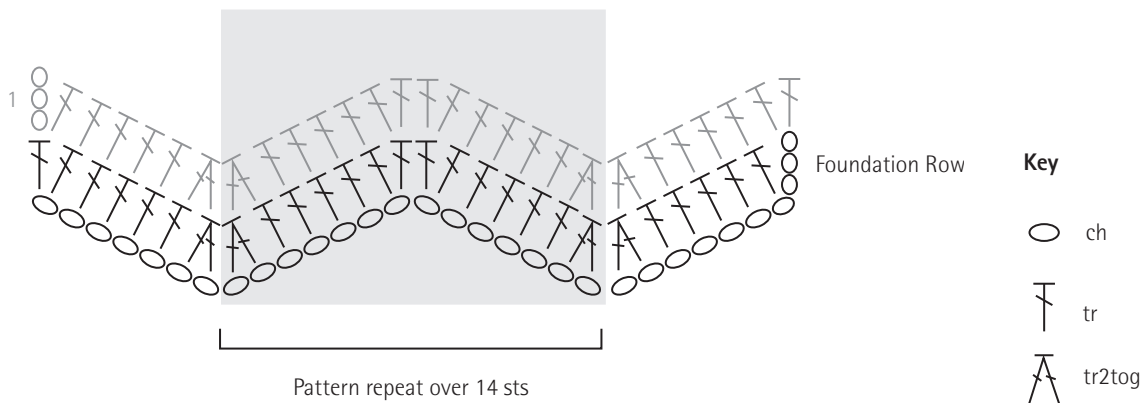

Yarn G* No Balls		2
Yarn	F075 Snuggly, DK, 50g, A shade 511 Angel, B shade 187 Precious, C shade 510 Rosebud, D shade 509 Sorbet, E shade 252 Lemon, F shade 512 Pea Shoot, G shade 419 Choo Choo Train	
You also need	I 4.00 (UK8 - USA F/5) Crochet Hook

## CHEVRON PATTERN



### STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

**NB** - These instructions use UK crochet terms throughout - US terms are given in brackets below where applicable.

**A** - shade A

**B** - shade B

**C** - shade C

**ch** - chain

**cm** - centimetres

**D** - shade D

**DK** - double knitting

**E** - shade E

**F** - shade F

**G** - shade G

**g** - grammes

**patt** - pattern

**rep** - repeat

**rs** - right side

**tog** - together

**tr** - treble (US double crochet)

**tr2tog** - (yoh, insert hook into next stitch, yoh and draw through, yoh and draw through 2 loops) twice, yoh and draw through 3 loops.

**yoh** - yarn over hook

Using 4.00 hook and A make 143ch.

**Foundation Row (rs).** 1tr into 4th ch from hook (first 3ch count as 1tr), 1tr into each of next 4ch, tr2tog, \* tr2tog, 1tr into each of next 4ch, (2tr into next ch) twice, 1tr into each of next 4ch, tr2tog, rep from \* to last 7ch, tr2tog, 1tr into each of next 4ch, 2tr into last ch, turn.

**1st Row.** 3ch (3ch counts as 1tr), 1tr into tr on which 3ch stands, 1tr

into each of next 4tr, tr2tog, \* tr2tog, 1tr into each of next 4tr, (2tr into next tr) twice, 1tr into each of next 4tr, tr2tog, rep from \* to last 7tr, tr2tog, 1tr into each of next 4tr, 2tr into last tr, turn.

1st row sets chevron patt. Keeping continuity of chevron patt as set work 98 rows in stripe sequence as follows:-

14 rows in A.

10 rows in B.

16 rows in C.

12 rows in D.

18 rows in E.

12 rows in F.

16 rows in G.

Fasten off.

### TO COMPLETE

Pin out blanket to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
