# A Day Out Blanket

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## Abbreviations

**k** - knit; **p** - purl; **rep** - repeat; **st(s)** - stitch(es);  
**sl** - slip; **wyif** - with yarn in front of work;  
**wyab** - with yarn at back of work; **LH** - left hand;  
**RH** - right hand; **yo** - yarn over needle;  
**tbl** - through back of loop; **pssso** - pass slipped st over; **tog** - together;

## BLOCK 9 (Make 8 in A)

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**MC** - mock cable - slip 1, k1, yo, k1, pass slipped st over these 3 sts.

**FC** - slip 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, k1, **then k1tbl, p1, k1tbl from cable needle.**

**BC** - slip next st onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, **then k1 from cable needle.**

**MB** - (K1, k1tbl) twice into next st to increase to 4 sts, (slip these 4 sts back to LH needle, k4) twice, pass first three sts one at a time over last st to decrease back to one st.

Using 5mm needles cast on 47 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** K1, (p1, k2) twice, p3, k2, p1, k7, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, k7, p1, k2, p3, (k2, p1) twice, k1.

**Row 2:** P1, (k1tbl, p2) twice, MC, p2, k1tbl, p6,

BC, k1 tbl, FC, p6, k1tbl, p2, MC, (p2, k1tbl) twice, p1.

**Row 3:** K1, (p1, k2) twice, p3, k2, p1, k6, (p1, k1) 4 times, p1, k6, p1, k2, p3, (k2, p1) twice, k1.

**Row 4:** P1, (k1tbl, p2) twice, k3, p2, k1tbl, p5, BC, k1, k1tbl, k1, FC, p5, k1tbl, p2, k3, (p2, k1tbl) twice, p1.

**Row 5:** K1, (p1, k2) twice, p3, k2, p1, k5, p1, k1, (p1, k2) twice, p1, k1, p1, k5, p1 k2, p3, (k2, p1) twice, k1.

**Row 6:** P1, (k1tbl, p2) twice, MC, p2, k1tbl, p4, BC, k2, k1tbl, k2, FC, p4, k1tbl, p2, MC (p2, k1tbl) twice, p1.

**Row 7:** K1, (p1, k2) twice, p3, k2, p1, k4, p1, k1, p2, k2, p1, k2, p2, k1, p1, k4, p1, k2, p3, (k2, p1) twice, k1.

**Row 8:** P1, (k1tbl, p2) twice, k3, p2, k1tbl, p3, BC, (k1tbl, k2) twice, k1tbl, FC, p3, k1tbl, p2, k3, (p2, k1tbl) twice, p1.

**Row 9:** K1, (p1, k2) twice, p3, k2, p1, k3, (p1, k1) twice, (p1, k2) twice, (p1, k1) twice, p1, k3, p1, k2, p3, (k2, p1) twice, k1.

**Row 10:** P1, (k1tbl, p2) twice, MC, p2, k1tbl, p2, BC, k1, (k1tbl, k2) twice, k1tbl, k1, FC, p2, k1tbl, p2, MC, (p2, k1tbl) twice, p1.

**Row 11:** K1, (p1, k2) twice, p3, k2, p1, k2, p1, k1, (p1, k2) 4 times, p1, k1, p1, k2, p1, k2, p3, (k2, p1) twice, k1.

**Row 12:** P1, (k1tbl, p2) twice, k3, p2, k1tbl, p1, BC, (k2, k1tbl) 3 times, k2, FC, p1, k1tbl, p2, k3, (p2, k1tbl) twice, p1.

**Row 13:** K1, (p1, k2) twice, p3, k2, p1, (k1, p1) twice, k3, (p1, k2) twice, p1, k3, (p1, k1) twice, p1, k2, p3, (k2, p1) twice, k1.

**Row 14:** P1, (k1tbl, p2) twice, MC, p2, k1tbl, (p1, k1tbl) twice, k3, (MB, p2) twice, MB, k3, (k1tbl, p1) twice, k1tbl, p2, MC, (p2, k1tbl) twice, p1.

**Row 15:** K1, (p1, k2) twice, p3, k2, p1, (k1, p1) twice, k3, (p1 tbl, k2) twice, p1tbl, k3, (p1, k1) twice, p1, k2, p3, (k2, p1) twice, k1.

**Row 16:** P1, (k1tbl, p2) twice, k3, p2, k1tbl, (p1, k1tbl) twice, p3, k1tbl, p1, k3 tbl, p1, k1tbl, p3, (k1tbl, p1) twice, k1tbl, p2, k3, (p2, k1tbl) twice, p1.

These 16 rows set pattern.

Rep these 16 rows once more, then rows 1 to  
15 once more.  
Cast off in patt.  
Block to 20cm x 20cm.
