# A Day Out Blanket

WEEK 1 - Wigshaw Lane



**Row 10:** P4, \* k2, p5, rep from \* to last 6 sts, k2, p4.

Rep these 10 rows 5 times more, then rows 1 and 2 twice more.

Cast off.

Block to 20cm x 20cm.

## Abbreviations

**k** - knit; **p** - purl; **rep** - repeat; **st(s)** - stitch(es);  
**sl** - slip; **wyif** - with yarn in front of work;  
**wyab** - with yarn at back of work; **LH** - left hand;  
**RH** - right hand; **yo** - yarn over needle;  
**tbl** - through back of loop; **pssso** - pass slipped st over; **tog** - together;

## BLOCK 1 (work 4 in A)

Using 5mm needles cast on 38 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2:** P4, \* k2, p5, rep from \* to last 6 sts, k2, p4.

Rep these 2 rows once, then row 1 once more.

**Row 6:** K3, \* sl1 wyif, k2 wyab, sl1 wyif, k3 wyab, rep from \* to end.

**Row 7:** K3, \* sl1 wyab, k2, sl1 wyab, k3, rep from \* to end.

**Row 8:** As row 6.

**Row 9:** K3, \* drop first slipped st off needle and leave at front of work, sl next 2 sts onto RH needle, then drop the next slipped st and leave at front of work, place the first dropped st onto LH needle before slipping the 2 sts moved onto RH needle back onto LH needle before picking up the second dropped st and place this on LH needle, knit across these 4 sts, k3, rep from \* to end.

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
