



# Another Day Out Blanket

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## Abbreviations

**k** - knit; **st(s)** - stitch(es); **sl** - slip;  
**yf** - yarn forward;

## Making Up

Sew all blocks together as shown in diagram.

### Edging

#### Lace edging option

Using 5mm needles and D cast on 7 sts.

**Row 1:** Knit.

**Row 2:** K2, yf twice to create a double loop, knit to end.

**Row 3:** Knit to end, working into front and back of double loop.

**Row 4:** Cast off 2 sts, knit to end.

These 4 rows set pattern.

Starting at centre of one side of your blanket work as set until work fits to first corner when slightly stretched.

**Row 1:** Knit.

**Row 2:** K2, yf twice, k3, wrap next st and turn.

**Row 3:** Knit to end, working into front and back of double loop.

**Row 4:** Cast off 2 sts, k3, wrap and turn.

**Row 5:** Knit.

**Row 6:** K2, yfwd twice, k1, wrap and turn.

**Row 7:** Knit to end, working into front and back

of double loop.

**Row 8:** Cast off 2 sts, k3, wrap and turn.

**Row 9:** Knit.

**Row 10:** K2, yfwd twice, k3, wrap and turn.

**Row 11:** Knit to end, working into front and back of double loop.

**Row 12:** Cast off 2 sts, knit to end.

Continue as set until edging fits round entire edge of blanket.

Join cast on and cast off edges of edging.

### G st edging option

Using 5mm needles and D cast on 7 sts.

**Row 1:** Knit.

**Row 2:** With yarn at front, slip 1, knit to end.

These 2 rows set g st and edging.

Starting at centre of one side of your blanket work as set until work fits to first corner when slightly stretched.

**Row 1:** Knit.

**Row 2:** With yarn at front slip 1, k4, wrap next st and turn.

**Row 3:** Knit.

**Row 4:** With yarn at front slip 1, k3, wrap and turn.

**Row 5:** Knit.

**Row 6:** With yarn at front slip 1, k2, wrap and turn.

**Row 7:** Knit.

**Row 8:** With yarn at front slip 1, k3, wrap and turn.

**Row 9:** Knit.

**Row 10:** With yarn at front slip 1, k4, wrap and turn.

Continue as set until edging fits round entire edge of blanket.

Join cast on and cast off edges of edging.

### Crochet option

Using a 5mm crochet hook and D work 1 round of double crochet evenly all round edge of block. Slip stitch to first stitch to join.

**Round 1:** 2 chain, 1 treble into each stitch to corner, 2 treble in corner, repeat to end. Slip stitch to 2<sup>nd</sup> ch at beg of round to join.

**Round 2:** 1 chain, 1 double crochet into each stitch to corner, 2 double crochet in corner stitch, repeat to end. Slip stitch to chain at beg

of round to join.

Repeat these 2 rounds once more.

Fasten off.
