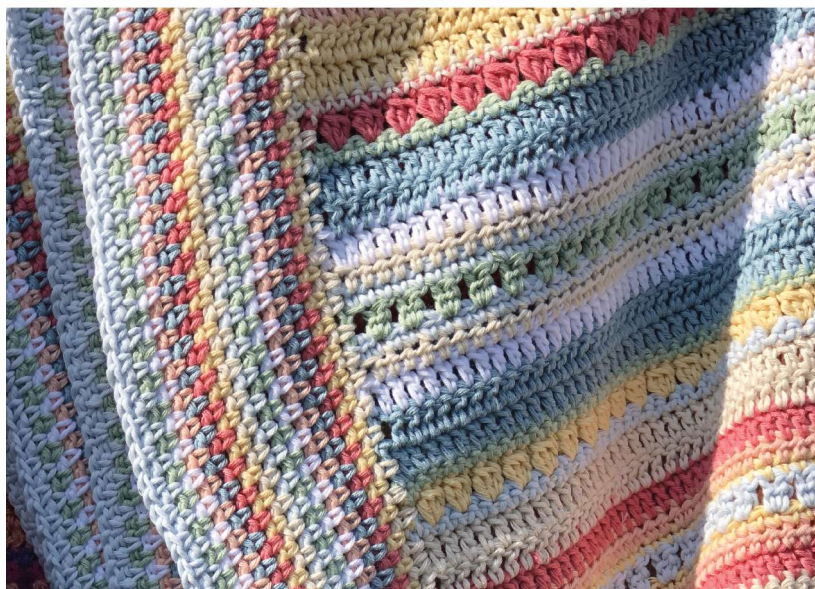

## Materials

8 shades of DK yarn - approximate requirements in metres.

A - 294m

B - 441m

C - 333m

D - 313m

E - 281m

F - 325m

G - 279m

H - 264m

**Hook** – recommended hook is 4.5mm for the initial chain and 4mm for the main body. However, please use the right hook to achieve the tension given.

Sewing up needle

## Tension

17 tr x 10 rows, to measure 10 x 10cm with 4mm hook (or hook size to achieve tension).

## Finished Size

139cm x 97cm

## Abbreviations

## Special Stitches

**Treble 2 cluster** – Yarn round hook, insert the hook in the next stitch, yarn round hook and pull the yarn through (3 loops on hook), yarn round hook and pull the yarn through the first two loops only. Yarn round hook, insert hook into the same stitch, yarn round hook and pull yarn through. Yarn round hook, pull through first two loops only. Yarn round hook and pull through 3 remaining loops.

**Treble 3 cluster** – Yarn round hook, insert the hook in the next stitch, yarn round hook and pull the yarn through (3 loops on hook), yarn round hook and pull the yarn through the first two loops only. Yarn round hook, insert hook into the same stitch, yarn round hook and pull yarn through. Yarn round hook, pull through first two loops only. Yarn round hook, insert hook into the same stitch, yarn round hook and pull yarn through. Yarn round hook, pull through first two loops only. Yarn round hook and pull through 4 remaining loops.

**Changing colour** – when changing colour at the end of a row, on the last stitch of the row, work the stitch until the last step of the stitch, when 2 loops are on hook. Drop old colour, pick up new colour and pull through last 2 loops to complete the stitch. New colour is now on hook ready to work next row.

## Pattern Rows

**Treble Row** – Ch3 (counts as a stitch), 1tr in each remaining stitch to the end, turn.

**DC Row** – Ch1 (does not count as a stitch), 1dc in first stitch, 1dc in each remaining stitch to the end, turn.

**Half Treble Row** – Ch2 (counts as a stitch), 1htr in each remaining stitch to the end, turn.

**Treble 2 cluster Row** – Ch4 (counts as 1tr, ch1), miss 1 st, treble 2 cluster in next stitch (see special stitches), [ ch1, miss 1 st, treble 2 cluster in next st] to last 2 stitches, ch1, miss 1 st, 1tr in tch from previous row.

**Treble 3 cluster Row** – Ch4 (counts as 1tr, ch1), miss 1 st, treble 3 cluster in next stitch (see special stitches), [ ch1, miss 1 st, treble 3 cluster in next st] to last 2 stitches, ch1, miss 1 st, 1tr in tch from previous row.

## Pattern

### Foundation Row

Using Colour A and a 4.5mm hook, ch154 & turn. Change to 4mm hook.

Miss 1 ch and then dc in every stitch to the end, turn – the first row of every crochet blanket is hard work – stick with it and take your time. (153 sts).

Now start working the pattern repeat, changing colours as detailed in the pattern and turning after each row. You will maintain 153 sts throughout.

### Pattern Repeat

Row 1 & 2 – Treble rows

Row 3 – Treble Row

Row 4 – Half treble row

Row 5 – DC row

Row 6 – Treble 2 cluster row – each row should have 75 treble clusters, 76 ch1 and 2 tr

Row 7 – DC Row

Row 8 – Half treble row

Row 9 – Treble row

Row 10 & 11 – Treble rows

Row 12 – DC row

Row 13 – Treble 3 cluster row – each row should have 75 treble clusters, 76 ch1 and 2 tr

Row 14 – DC row

Repeat last 14 rows, 11 times following the

colour charts released each week and ending after Row 12 of the final pattern repeat.

A sample chart is provided for reference on page 3.

## Border

### Round 1

This blanket can be reversible, so pick which side you'd like to be the front. Then with the RS facing, make a slip knot onto hook with Colour B and join with ss to the first DC of the last row. Ch 1, (not counted as a stitch), (1dc, ch2, 1dc) into same dc at base of ch1 – (first corner made), ch1, skip next stitch, \*[1dc into next stitch, ch1, skip next stitch] to next corner stitch, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) into next corner stitch, ch1 skip next stitch; repeat from \*all around until the full border has been worked, and you have reached the first stitch, ss into first dc to join. Fasten off. To ensure your border is even work in dc in each row of the pattern

NB: Don't stress if you are a stitch out, no one will ever know!

### Round 2

Join the new colour to any corner ch2 space, ch1 (not counted as a st), \*(1dc, ch2, 1dc) into corner ch2 space, ch1, miss next dc, [1dc into next ch1 space, ch1, miss next dc] to next corner space; repeat from \* all around until you have reached the first st, ss into first dc to join. Fasten off.

Repeat round 2 another 16 times using the next shade in the sequence.

Fasten off and darn in any ends.

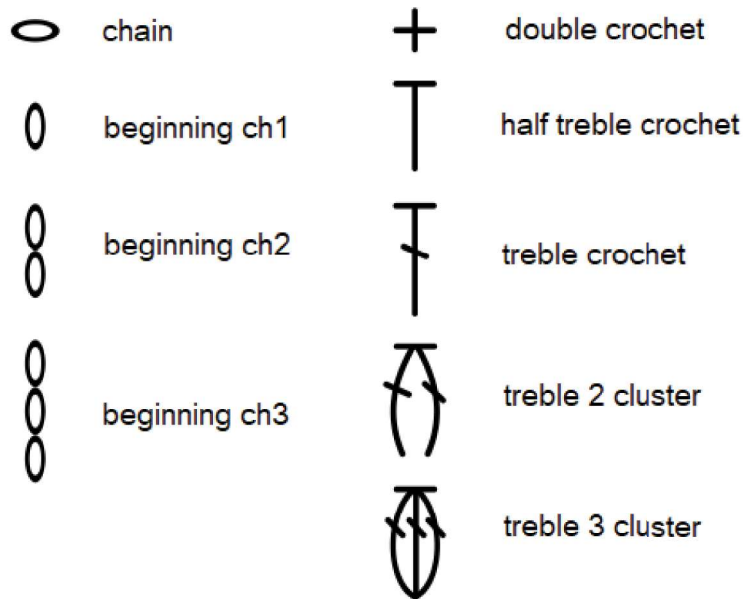
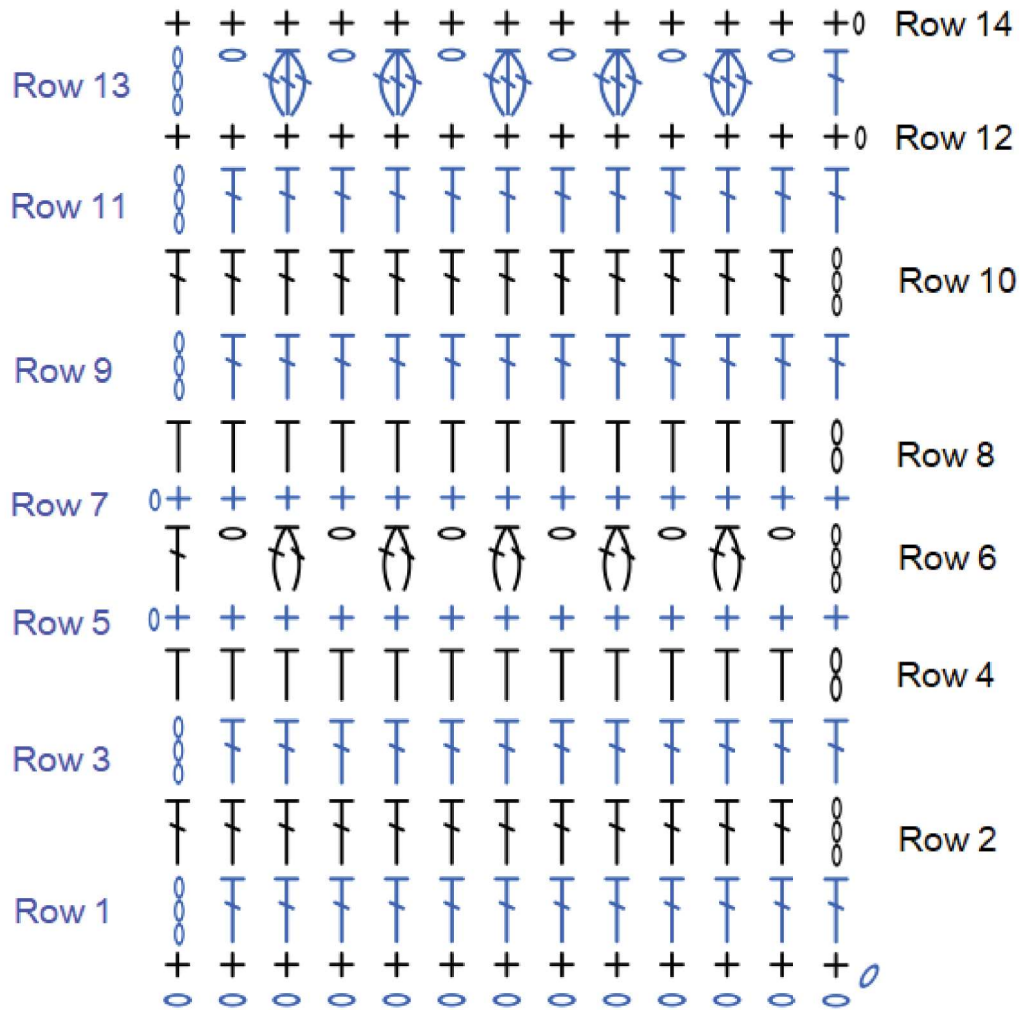
