- (includes half of sleeve top)
- C 16 [16:17:17:18] cm (61/4 [61/4:61/2:61/2:7]") (includes half of sleeve top)
- D 13 [13:13:13] cm (5¼ [5¼:5¼:5¼:5½]")
- E 16.5 [16.5:17.5:18:19] cm (6¼ [6¼:6¾:7:7½]")
- (6¼ [6¼:6¾:7:7½]") (excluding front borders)
- F 17 [17:18:18:18] cm (6½ [6½:7:7:7]") 28 [30:32:34:36] cm
- G 28 [30:32:34:36] cm (11 [11%:12½:13½:14]")



### STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

A - shade A

alt - alternate

B - shade B

beg - beginning

C - shade C

cm - centimetres

**dec** - decrease(ing)

**DK** - double knitting

**St-st** (stocking stitch). **Ist Row.** Knit.

2nd Row. Purl. Rep these 2 rows.

Stripe Sequence: 8 rows in A, 2 rows in B, 2 rows in C, 6 rows in B, 2 rows in C. 2 rows in B.

#### **BACK**

Using 31/4mm needles, thumb method and B, cast on 77 [79:83:85:89] sts.

Ist Row. Using A, \* kI, pI, rep from \* to last st, kI.

**2nd Row.** Using A, p1, \* k1, p1, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as IxI rib.

\*\* Using C, work 2 rows more in IxI rib.

Using B, work 2 rows more in 1x1 rib. Using C, work 2 rows more in 1x1 rib. Using A, work 2 rows more in 1x1 rib. Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

Working in st-st and starting with IIth [7th:3rd:19th:17th] row of stripe sequence as shown on chart, work 64 [68:72:78:80] rows. \*\*

Working in st-st and stripe sequence (throughout) proceed as follows:-

#### **SHAPE RAGLAN**

Cast off 4 [5:5:5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 69 [69:73:75:79] sts.

Next Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. 67 [67:71:73:77] sts.

Next Row. P1, p2tog, purl to last 3 sts, p2togtbl, p1. 65 [65:69:71:75] sts.

Last 2 rows set raglan shapings.

For 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only Work [2:4:8] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in every row. [65:63:59] sts.

For all 5 sizes

Next Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last
3 sts, k2tog, k1. 63 [63:63:61:57] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Last 2 rows set raglan shapings. Work 34 [34:34:32:28] rows dec I st at each end as before in next and every foll alt row. 29 sts.

Cast off rem 29 sts.

#### **LEFT FRONT**

Using 3<sup>1</sup>/4mm needles, thumb method and B, cast on 36 [36:38:40:42] sts. **Ist Row.** Using A, \* kI, pI, rep from \* to end.

1st row sets rib.

Using A, work I row more in rib.
Work as given for Back from \*\* to \*\*.
Working in st-st and stripe sequence (throughout) proceed as follows:-

#### SHAPE RAGLAN AND NECK

Next Row. Cast off 4 [5:5:5:5] sts, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog (neck edge).
31 [30:32:34:36] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Next Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 2 [0:0:2:2] sts, (k2tog) 1 [0:0: l:1] times. 29 [29:31:32:34] sts.

Next Row. Purl to last 3 sts, p2togtbl, p1.28 [28:30:31:33] sts.

Last 2 rows set raglan and neck shapings.

For 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only Work [2:4:8] rows dec I st at raglan edge as before in every row AT SAMETIME dec I st at neck edge in [Ist:3rd:3rd] and every foll [0:0:4th] row. [27:26:23] sts.

For all 5 sizes

Next Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit
to last 2 [2:0:0:0] sts, (k2tog)

I [1:0:0:0] times. 26 [26:26:25:22] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Work 23 [23:21:21:17] rows dec I st at raglan edge as before in next and every foll alt row AT SAME TIME dec I st at neck edge in 3rd [3rd:1st:

Ist: Ist] and every foll 4th row. 8 [8:9:8:8] sts.

Work 10 [10:12:10:10] rows dec 1 st at raglan edge only as before in 2nd and every foll alt row. 3 sts. Next Row. Purl to end.

Leave these rem 3 sts on a safety pin.

#### **RIGHT FRONT**

Using 31/4mm needles, thumb method and B, cast on 36 [36:38:40:42] sts. **Ist Row.** Using A, \* p1, k1, rep from \* to end.

1st row sets rib.

Using A, work I row more in rib. Work as given for Back from \*\* to \*\*. Working in st-st and stripe sequence (throughout) proceed as follows:-

#### SHAPE NECK AND RAGLAN

Next Row. K2tog, knit to end. 35 [35: 37:39:41] sts.

Next Row. Cast off 4 [5:5:5:5] sts, purl to end. 31 [30:32:34:36] sts.

Next Row. (K2tog) | [0:0:1:1] times, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

29 [29:31:32:34] sts.

**Next Row.** PI, p2tog, purl to end. 28 [28:30:31:33] sts.

Last 2 rows set neck and raglan shapings.

For 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only

Work [2:4:8] rows dec I st at neck edge in [Ist:3rd:3rd] and every foll [0:0:4th] row AT SAMETIME dec I st at raglan edge as before in every row. [27:26:23] sts.

For all 5 sizes

Next Row. (K2tog) | [1:0:0:0] times, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

26 [26:26:25:22] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Work 23 [23:21:17] rows dec I st at neck edge in 3rd [3rd:|st:|st:|st] and every foll 4th row AT SAMETIME dec I st at raglan edge as before in next and every foll alt row.

8 [8:9:8:8] sts.

Work 10 [10:12:10:10] rows dec 1 st at raglan edge only as before in 2nd and every foll alt row. 3 sts.

Next Row. Purl to end.

Leave these rem 3 sts on a safety pin.

#### SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 31/4mm needles, thumb method and B, cast on 37 [37:39:39:39] sts. Using A, work 2 rows in 1x1 rib. Using C, work 2 rows more in 1x1 rib.

Using B, work 2 rows more in 1x1 rib. Using C, work 2 rows more in 1x1 rib. Using A, work 2 rows more in 1x1 rib. Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

Working in st-st and stripe sequence (throughout) starting with 7th [1st:17th: 11th:17th] row of stripe sequence work 9 [47:53:35:29] rows inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 4th [6th: 6th:6th:6th] row to 41 [53:57:51:49] sts. Work 48 [16:16:40:48] rows inc 1 st at each end of every foll 6th [8th:8th: 8th:8th] row to 57 [57:61:61:61] sts. Work | | [||:||:||3] rows more without shaping.

#### **SHAPE RAGLAN**

Cast off 4 [5:5:5:5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 49 [47:51:51:51] sts.

Next Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. 47 [45:49:49:49] sts.

Next Row. Purl. Next Row. Knit.

Next Row. Purl.

For 2nd and 5th sizes only

Work [4:8] rows dec I st at each end of next and every foll [0:4th] row. [43:45] sts.

For all 5 sizes

1st Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. 45 [41:47:47:43] sts. 2nd Row. Purl.

Last 2 rows set raglan shapings. Work 32 [28:34:34:26] rows dec I st at each end as before in next and every foll alt row. 13 [13:13:17] sts. Cast off rem [3 [13:13:17] sts.

#### RIGHT FRONT BORDER

Join raglan seams. With rs facing, using 31/4mm needles and A, starting at lower edge of right front, pick up and knit 9 sts evenly along rib, 60 [66:68:74:76] sts evenly along straight edge, 33 [33:35: 35:35] sts evenly along shaped edge, knit across 3 sts left on a safety pin at top of raglan, pick up and knit 16 [16: 16:16:20] sts from 13 [13:13:13:17] cast off sts at top of right sleeve and 18 sts to centre back of neck. 139 [145:149:155:161] sts. Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib,

work I row. Using C, work 2 rows more in rib.

Next Row. Using B, rib 4 [4:4:2:4], cast off 2 sts in rib, (rib 17 [19:14:16:16], cast off 2 sts in rib) 3 [3:4:4:4] times, rib to end.









Next Row. Using B, rib to last 58 [64: 64:70:72] sts, cast on 2 sts, (rib 18 [20: 15:17:17] seet on 2 sts) 3 [3:44:4] since	NOTES:	
15:17:17], cast on 2 sts) 3 [3:4:4:4] times, rib 4 [4:4:2:4]. Using C, work 2 rows more in rib.		
Using A, work 2 rows more in rib. Using B, cast off in rib.		
LEFT FRONT BORDER		
With rs facing, using 3½mm needles and A, starting at centre back of neck		
pick up and knit 18 sts along back of neck, 16 [16:16: 16:20] sts from 13 [13:13:17] cast		
off sts at top of left sleeve, knit across 3 sts left on a safety pin at top of		
raglan, pick up and knit 33 [33:35: 35:35] sts evenly along shaped edge, 60 [66:68:74:76] sts		
evenly along straight edge and 9 sts evenly along rib.		
139 [145:149:155:161] sts.  Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib, work 1 row.		
Using C, work 2 rows more in rib. Using B, work 2 rows more in rib.		
Using C, work 2 rows more in rib. Using A, work 2 rows more in rib. Using B, cast off in rib.		
TO MAKE UP		
Join side and sleeve seams. Sew seam at back of neck. Sew on buttons. Pin		
out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and		
leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
