Mesh Bag Kit

Materials:

- 2x ReTwisst Chainy Cotton
- 1x Crochet Hook 3mm

Used Techniques:

- · Chain (ch)
- Single crochet (sc)
- · Double crochet (dc)
- Slip stitch (sl st)

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Mesh Bag Kit

1st row: Chain 36x, skip 4x chains and insert the crochet hook into 5th chain, make a dc. Then chain 2x skip one chain hole and crochet a dc into next chain. Continue to crochet like this till end of the row (chain 2x, skip one, crochet dc). You should have totally 16x square holes.

2nd row: Chain 5x, turn the crochet piece over and start to crochet to the opposite side. Make a dc into each dc from previous row until end of the row. Do not forget to chain 2x between all squares. Into last square (which is 5x pulled chain hole) crochet 2x dc with 2x chain between each. That will allow you to get the rotation to the opposite side. Continue to crochet squares over squares until end of the row.

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3rd row: Chain 3x (count as one dc), turn the piece over. Crochet 1x dc into the square hole and 1x dc into dc from prev row. Continue to crochet dc until to the corner. To the first square at the corner crochet 3x dc, chain 2x and make again 3x dc into same hole to get the increasement. To the second hole from prev row 1x dc into square and 1x dc over dc.

To the third square repeat the increasement process as by the first. Then continue to crochet dc's at the opposite side until end of the row. 4th row: Chain 5x, turn over and start to crochet square hole by skipping one dc and 2x chain between each. At the corner make the first square into the corner hole from prev row. Chain 2x again a dc into same hole. Chain 2x and crochet dc into first dc from prev row. Crochet the rest usual square holes

Repeat the same process as on the other corner and continue to crochet squares to the opposite side.

5th row: Chain 5x, turn over and continue to crochet squares over squares. At the corner part increase the square holes by making 2x dc (2x chain between each) to the middle corner hole from prev row. The same also on the other corner and the rest as usual square over square.

6th row: Repeat 5th row. *7th row:* Repeat 5th row.

until to the next corner.





8th row: At this row the handles should be crochted. Chain therefore 65x and fix it with a sc into first hole from opposite side. Chain 3x and crochet dc into each square and over all dc from prev row until to the middle corner hole. Crochet into that hole 3x dc, chain 2x and again 3x dc into same hole. Repeat increasement also by the other corner part. The rest as usual dc all around. Crochet also over the handle chains dc into every chain hole. So the handles would be more stronger.

Close with a sl st into first dc.

9th row: Chain 5x, turn over and start to crochet again squares over squares. Do not forget the increasement parts at the corners as by row 5.

10th row: Repeat 9th row. 11th row: Repeat 9th row. 12th row: Repeat 9th row.

13th row: Chain 3x, turn over and crochet all around dc including the increasement parts at the corners.


Now the first half of mesh bag is completed.

Start to crochet the other half of the bag by following the same processes as on the first half.

Finally, sew the two parts together with some yarn by using a wool needle. Your mesh bag is ready to use.
