

Peppermint Tea Triangle



A top down triangle shawl, so easy to wear no matter the season.

A magical textured leafy stitch pattern throughout for a relaxing make, finished with lacy peaks.

Add a fab fringe and slurp up every drop of the calming Peppermint Tea



Materials

1 x Scheepjes Whirl – Sea Breeze Tease 60% cotton / 40% acrylic

1000 metres

3.5 mm crochet hook

Stitch Marker

Needle for sewing in ends

Finished shawl size

156 cm x 78 cm

ch chain

dc double crochet tr treble crochet

ch-1sp chain space made with 1 ch ch-2sp chain space made with 2 ch

FP/tr-tog see Special Stitches
tr/FP-tog see Special Stitches

FPtr front post treble crochet

Pattern Notes:

Even numbered rows are right side rows.

- The shawl is worked from the top down, stitches increase with each row. The stitches in bold – signify the centre spine of the shawl. The pattern is mirrored either side of the centre ch-2sp
- The stitch count at the end of the row indicates the stitches on one side of the centre ch-2sp only the same quantity of stitches are mirrored on the other side too
- Wet block your shawl using measurements as a guide.

Special Stitches

FPtr:

Front Post treble crochet:

Yarn over hook, insert hook from front to back, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the front again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 2 loops.

FP/tr-tog:

Treble Crochet 2 stitches together, with the first stitch worked around front post: Yarn over hook, insert hook from front to back, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the front again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over hook, insert hook into top of next stitch, yarn over hook pull yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 3 loops

tr/FPtr-tog:

Treble Crochet 2 stitches together, with the second stitch worked around front post:

Yarn over hook, insert hook into top of next stitch, yarn over hook pull yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, insert hook from front to back, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the front again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 3 loops

BP/tr-tog:

Treble Crochet 2 stitches together, with the first stitch worked around back post: Yarn over hook, insert hook from back to front, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the back again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over hook, insert hook into top of next stitch, yarn over hook pull yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 3 loops

tr/BPtr-toq:

Treble Crochet 2 stitches together, with the second stitch worked around front post: Yarn over hook, insert hook into top of next stitch, yarn over hook pull yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, insert hook from back to front, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the back again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 3 loops

Cluster:

3 tr together in same stitch.

(Yarn over hook, insert hook in indicated stich or ch-sp, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook, pull through 2 loops) 3 times, yarn over hook pull yarn through 4 remaining loops on hook.

Cluster-3: (Cluster, ch 2, Cluster, ch 2, Cluster) in ch-3sp

Start

Set Up Rows

Row 1: into a magic ring work: ch 3 (counts as first tr, now and throughout), tr, ch 1, 2 tr **ch** 2 (place SM in centre ch-2sp), 2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr. Turn

4 tr, 1 ch-1sp (stitch count – these are the stitches on one side of the centre ch-2sp only – see pattern notes)

Row 2: Ch 3, skip tr, (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in next ch-1sp, skip 2 tr, (tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 tr, (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in ch-1sp, skip tr, tr in last tr (the last tr is the 3rd ch from beginning chains from previous row, now and throughout). Turn 8 tr, 1 ch-1sp

Row 3: Ch 3, skip next tr, *(2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 1, skip [tr, ch-1sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr,* skip 2 tr, (tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip next 2 tr, repeat from * to *, skip next tr, tr in last tr. Turn 10 tr, 3 ch-1sp

Row 4: Ch 3, tr in first tr, ch 1, skip 2 tr, *(2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp,* ch 2, skip 3 tr, (tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), ch 2, skip 3 tr, repeat from * to *, ch 1, skip 2 tr, 2 tr in last tr. Turn 11 tr, 4 ch-1sp, 1 ch-2sp



Row 5: Ch 3, (tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in first tr, ch 2, skip [tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], *tr in next ch-1sp, (tr in each of next 2 tr, tr in ch-1sp) twice, ch 2*, skip [2 tr, ch-2sp], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, **ch 2** (move SM to this ch-2sp), (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 tr], repeat from * to *, skip [2 tr, ch-1sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in last tr. Turn 15 tr, 2 ch-2sp, 2 ch-1sp

Row 6: Ch 3, skip next tr, *(3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in ch-1sp, ch 2, skip [2 tr, ch-2sp], FP/tr-2tog over next 2 tr, tr in each of next 3 tr, tr/FP-2tog over next 2 tr, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 tr] (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in ch-1sp*, skip 2 tr, (**tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-2sp** (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 tr, repeat from * to *, skip next tr, tr in last tr. Turn 19 tr, 2 ch-2sp, 2 ch-1sp (2tog stitches are counted as one tr)

Row 7: Ch 3, skip next tr, *(2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 1, skip [tr, ch-1sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 2, skip [tr, ch-2sp], BP/tr-2tog over next 2 tr, tr in next tr, tr/BP-2tog over next 2 tr, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 1, skip [tr, ch-1sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr*, skip 2 tr, (tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 tr, repeat from * to *, tr in last tr. Turn

21 tr, 2 ch-2sp, 6 ch-1sp (2tog stitches are counted as one tr)

Row 8: Ch 3, tr in first tr, ch 1, skip 2 tr, *(2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, ch 2, skip [2 tr,ch-2sp,tr], FPtr in next tr, ch 2 skip [tr, ch-2sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp*, ch 2, skip 3 tr, **(tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-2sp** (move SM to ch-2sp), ch 2,



skip 3 tr, repeat from * to *, ch 1, skip 2 tr, 2 tr in last tr. Turn 20 tr, 7 ch-1sp, 3 ch-2sp

The Pattern

Note: the pattern repeat either side of the centre **ch2** is underlined

Row 9: Ch 3, (tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in first tr, ch 2, skip [tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], tr in next ch-1sp, (tr in each of next 2 tr, tr in ch-1sp) twice, ch 2, skip [2 tr, ch-2sp], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, *ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 tr], tr in next ch-1sp, (tr in each of next 2 tr, tr in ch-1sp) twice, ch 2, skip [2 tr, ch-2sp], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, repeat from * to SM, ch 2 (move SM to this ch-2sp), (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 tr], tr in next ch-1sp, (tr in each of next 2 tr, tr in ch-1sp) twice, ch 2, **skip [2 tr, ch-2sp], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 tr], tr in next ch-1sp, (tr in each of next 2 tr, tr in ch-1sp)



twice, ch 2, repeat from ** across to last [2 tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], skip [2 tr, ch-1sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in last tr. Turn 26 tr, 4 ch-2sp, 3 ch-1sp

Row 10: Ch 3, skip next tr, (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in ch-1sp, *ch 2, skip [2 tr, ch-2sp], FP/tr-2tog over next 2 tr, tr in each of next 3 tr, tr/FP-2tog over next 2 tr, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 tr] (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in ch-1sp, repeat from * across to 2 tr before SM, skip 2 tr, (tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 tr, (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in ch-1sp, **ch 2, skip [2 tr, ch-2sp], FP/tr-2tog over next 2 tr, tr in each of next 3 tr, tr/FP-2tog over next 2 tr, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 tr] (3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr) in ch-1sp, repeat from ** to last 2 tr, skip next tr, tr in last tr. Turn 30 tr, 4 ch-2sp, 3 ch-1sp (2tog stitches are counted as one tr)

Row 11: Ch 3, *skip next tr, (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 1, skip [tr, ch-1sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, *ch 2, skip [tr, ch-2sp], BP/tr-2tog over next 2 tr, tr in next tr, tr/BP-2tog over next 2 tr, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 1, skip [tr, ch-1sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, repeat from * across to 2 tr before SM, skip 2 tr, (tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 tr, (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 1, skip [tr, ch-1sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, **ch 2, skip [tr, ch-2sp], BP/tr-2tog over next 2 tr, tr in next tr, tr/BP-2tog over next 2 tr, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr, ch 1, skip [tr, ch-1sp, tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next tr repeat from ** across to last 2 tr, skip tr, tr in last tr. Turn 32 tr, 4 ch-2sp, 9 ch-1sp (2tog stitches are counted as one tr)

Row 12: Ch 3, tr in first tr, ch 1, skip 2 tr, (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, *ch 2, skip [2 tr, ch-2sp, tr], FPtr in next tr, ch 2 skip [tr, ch-2sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, repeat from * across to 3 tr before SM, ch 2, skip 3 tr, (tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 3 tr, (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, **ch 2, skip [2 tr, ch-2sp, tr], FPtr in next tr, ch 2 skip [tr, ch-2sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1sp, repeat from ** across to last 3 tr, ch 1, skip 2 tr, 2 tr in last tr. Turn 29 tr, 10 ch-1sp, 5 ch-2sp

Rows 13 – 52: Repeat Rows 9 - 12 ten times more or as many times as you wish depending on the size shawl you'd like

Border

Row 1: Ch 6 (counts as tr, ch 3), tr in first tr, skip [tr, ch-1sp, tr], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [ch-1sp, 2 tr], (tr, ch 3, tr) into next ch (see pattern notes), skip [2 tr, ch-1sp], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [tr, ch-2sp], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, *skip [ch-2sp, tr], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [ch-1sp, 2 tr], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [2 tr, ch-1sp], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [tr, ch-2sp], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [ch-1sp, 2 tr], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [ch-1sp], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, *skip [tr, ch-2sp], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [ch-1sp, 2 tr], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [ch-1sp, 2 tr], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [ch-1sp, 2 tr], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [ch-1sp, 2 tr], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, skip [tr, ch-1sp], (tr, ch 3, tr) in next tr, repeat from ** across to last [tr, ch-1sp, 2 tr], skip [tr, ch-1sp, tr] (tr, ch 3, tr) in last tr. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, Cluster-3 (see Special Stitches) in ch-3sp, *ch 1, skip 2 tr, dc in next ch-3sp, ch 1, skip 2 tr, Cluster-3 in next ch-3sp, repeat from * to tr before SM, skip tr, (tr, ch 2, tr) in centre ch-sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip tr, Cluster-3 in next ch-3sp, **ch 1, skip 2 tr, dc in



next ch-3sp, ch 1, skip 2 tr, Cluster-3 in next ch-3sp, repeat from ** to last tr, tr in last tr. Turn

Row 3: ch 1(does not count as a stitch), dc in 1st tr, ch 5, dc in middle cluster, *ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 5, dc in middle cluster, repeat across to centre ch-2sp, **(tr, ch 6, tr)** in centre ch-sp, ch 5, dc in middle cluster, **ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 5, dc in middle cluster, repeat from ** across to last cluster, ch 5, dc in last tr. Turn

Round 4: ch 1 (does not count as a stitch), (dc, ch 3, dc) in 1st dc, 5 dc in ch-5-loop, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, 5 dc in ch-5-loop, *skip dc, 5 dc in next ch-5-loop, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, 5 dc in next ch-5-loop, repeat from * tr before centre ch-2sp, dc in next tr, **(4 tr, ch3, 4tr) in centre ch-6-loop**, dc in next tr, 5 dc in ch-5-loop, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, 5 dc in ch-5-loop, *skip dc, 5 dc in next ch-5-loop, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, 5 dc in next ch-5-loop, repeat from to last dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in last dc. Fasten Off

Finishing

Sew in all ends

For best results, block the shawl using measurements as a guide.

Add a fringe



Use 7 x strands cut to approx. 18 cm for each fringe

Use some card to wrap the yarn around to save measuring each time.

Keep the strands folded







Pull the strands through.

With your fingers, open up the loop created grab the strands and pull

through

Place the crochet hook through the stitch or the ch-1sp from top to bottom, grab the strands with the hook.



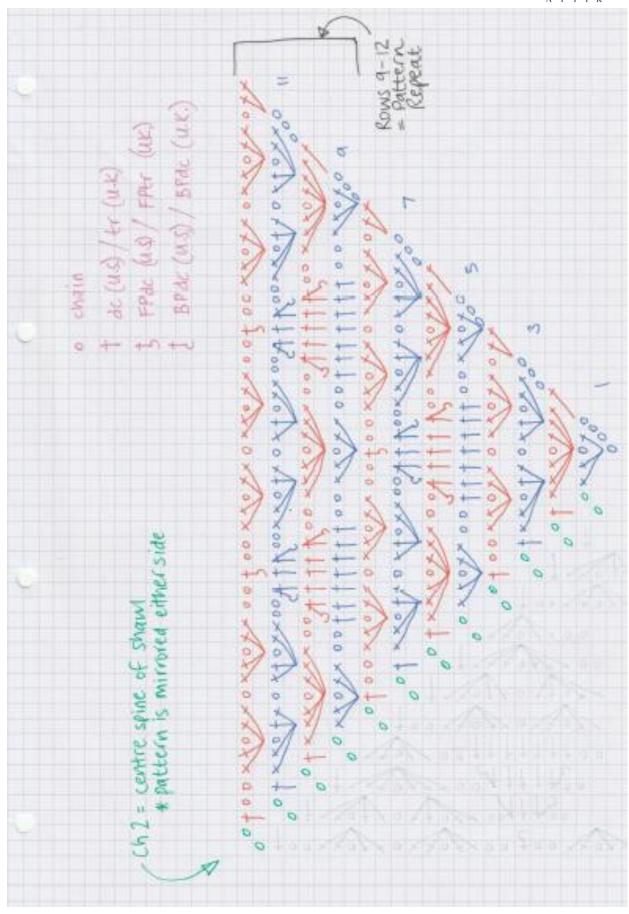




Pull to tighten.

Trim the fringe to neaten the edges once all have been added.
