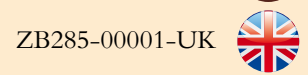
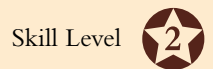

NEEDLES

- 1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles
- 1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

BUTTONS – 7 x G422830 in copper from Groves and Banks. Please see information page for contact details.

TENSION

22 sts and 31 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 4mm (US 6) needles.

BACK

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles cast on 107 [121: 133: 145: 157] sts.

Row 1 (RS): P1, *K1 tbl, P1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 17 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Row 20 (WS): Rib 7 [5: 5: 5: 6], work 2 tog, (rib 11 [10: 9: 10: 9], work 2 tog) 7 [9: 11: 11: 13] times, rib 7 [6: 5: 6: 6]. 99 [111: 121: 133: 143] sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg with a K row, now work in st st throughout as follows:

Cont straight until back meas 31 [31.5: 32: 32.5: 33] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 4 [5: 6: 7: 8] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

91 [101: 109: 119: 127] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 [7: 7: 9: 9] rows, then on foll 4 [5: 6: 5: 6] alt rows.

73 [77: 83: 91: 97] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 19 [20.5: 22: 23.5: 25] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Cast off 5 [5: 6: 7: 7] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

63 [67: 71: 77: 83] sts.

Next row (RS): Cast off 5 [5: 6: 7: 7] sts, K until there are 12 [14: 14: 16: 18] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row, **and at same time** cast off 5 [5: 6: 7: 7] sts at beg of 2nd row.

Cast off rem 4 [6: 5: 6: 8] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 29 [29: 31: 31: 33] sts onto a holder (for neckband), rejoin yarn and K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles cast on 57 [65: 69: 77: 81] sts.

Row 1 (RS): *P1, K1 tbl, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 2: K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 17 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Row 20 (WS): Rib 16 [14: 15: 14: 16], work 2 tog, (rib 14 [9: 13: 9: 12], work 2 tog) 2 [4: 3: 5: 4] times, rib 7 [5: 7: 6: 7].

54 [60: 65: 71: 76] sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): K to last 9 sts, rib 9.

Next row: Rib 9, P to end.

These 2 rows set the sts – front opening edge 9 sts still in rib with all other sts now in st st.

Keeping sts correct as now set throughout, cont as follows:

Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armhole

Cast off 4 [5: 6: 7: 8] sts at beg of next row.

50 [55: 59: 64: 68] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 5 [7: 7: 9: 9] rows, then on foll 4 [5: 6: 5: 6] alt rows.

41 [43: 46: 50: 53] sts.

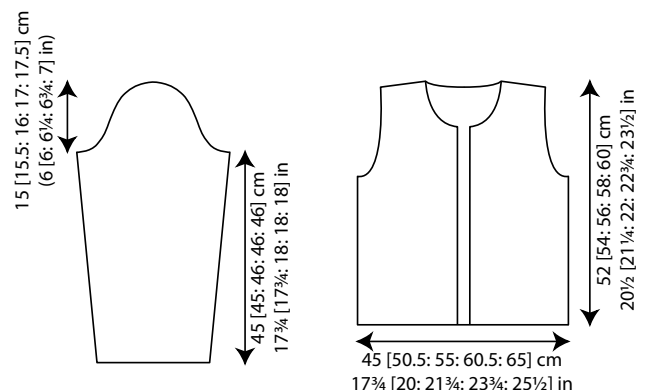
Cont straight until 26 [26: 28: 28: 30] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): K30 [32: 35: 39: 42] and turn, leaving rem 11 sts on a holder (for neckband).

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll 3 [3: 4: 4: 5] alt rows, then on foll 4th row, then on foll 6th row. 19 [21: 23: 27: 29] sts.

Work 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.



Shape shoulder

Cast off 5 [5: 6: 7: 7] sts at beg of next and foll 2 alt rows.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 4 [6: 5: 6: 8] sts.

Mark positions for 7 buttons along left front opening edge – first button to come level with row 7, last button to come 1 cm above neck shaping, and rem 5 buttons evenly spaced between.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles cast on 57 [65: 69: 77: 81] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *K1 tbl, P1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Row 7 (RS): Rib 3, K2tog tbl, yfwd (to make a buttonhole), patt to end.

Making a further 5 buttonholes in this way to correspond with positions marked for buttons on left front and noting that no further reference will be made to buttonholes, cont as folls:

Work in rib for a further 12 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Row 20 (WS): Rib 7 [5: 7: 6: 7], work 2 tog, (rib 14 [9: 13: 9: 12], work 2 tog) 2 [4: 3: 5: 4] times, rib 16 [14: 15: 14: 16]. 54 [60: 65: 71: 76] sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): Rib 9, K to end.

Next row: P to last 9 sts, rib 9.

These 2 rows set the sts – front opening edge 9 sts still in rib with all other sts now in st st.

Complete to match left front, reversing shapings and working first row of neck shaping as folls:

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): Patt 11 sts and slip these sts onto a holder (for neckband), K to end.

30 [32: 35: 39: 42] sts.

SLEEVES

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles cast on 49 [51: 53: 53: 55] sts.

Work in rib as given for back for 20 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg with a K row, now work in st st throughout as folls:

Work 6 [6: 6: 4: 4] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K2, M1, K to last 2 sts, M1, K2.

Working all sleeve increases as set by last row, inc 1 st at each end of 8th [8th: 8th: 6th: 6th] and every foll 10th [8th: 8th: 6th: 6th] row to 71 [65: 75: 65: 75] sts, then on every foll – [10th: 10th: 8th: 8th] row until there are – [75: 79: 83: 87] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 45 [45: 46: 46: 46] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Cast off 4 [5: 6: 7: 8] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

63 [65: 67: 69: 71] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on foll alt row, then on 6 foll 4th rows.

43 [45: 47: 49: 51] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row until 35 sts rem, then on foll 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 25 sts.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 17 sts.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Neckband

With RS facing and using 3¼mm (US 3) needles, slip 11 sts on right front holder onto right needle, rejoin yarn and pick up and knit 22 [22: 24: 24: 26] sts up right side of front neck, and 3 sts down right side of back neck, K across 29 [29: 31: 31: 33] sts on back holder, pick up and knit 3 sts up left side of back neck, and 22 [22: 24: 24: 26] sts down left side of front neck, then patt across 11 sts on left front holder. 101 [101: 107: 107: 113] sts.

Row 1 (WS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K1, K1 tbl, *P1, K1 tbl, rep from * to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 7 rows, making 7th buttonhole as before in 2nd of these rows and ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

See information page for finishing instructions, setting in sleeves using the set-in method.
