Betwixtmas Faroe Shawl

- Materials -

3 x King Cole Natural Alpaca DK (100m per 50g hank) 1 x 4.5mm 80cm circular needle 1 x 4mm 80cm circular needle Stitch markers

- Finished Size -

Width: approx 148cm Length: approx 40cm

- Tension -

Yarn needle

20sts x 26 rows before blocking over 10cm stocking stitch using 4.5mm needle.

- Abbreviations -

K knit P purl

yfwd yarn forward K2tog knit 2 together

K2togtbl knit 2 together through back loop

SI slip

psso pass slip stitch over PM place marker

SM slip marker st(s) stitch(es) rep repeat RS right side WS wrong side

- Pattern Note -

It is important to check your tension, as the shawl uses almost the full 3 hanks of yarn. If you are running short on yarn, cast off after row 2 of the garter stitch border has been completed.

- To Make -

Using yarn and 4.5mm needles cast on 11 sts.

Set up row: Knit to end.

Row 1(RS): (K1, yfwd) twice, K3, yfwd, K1, yfwd,

K3, (yfwd, K1) twice. (17 sts).

Row 2 (WS): K3, purl to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 3: (K1, yfwd) twice, K5, yfwd, K3, yfwd, K5,

(yfwd, K1) twice. (23 sts).

Row 4: Rep row 2.

Row 5: (K1, yfwd) twice, K7, yfwd, K5, yfwd, K7,

(yfwd, K1) twice. (29 sts).

Row 6 (WS): Knit to end.

Row 7: (K1, yfwd) twice, K9, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd,

K3, yfwd, K9, (yfwd, K1) twice. (35 sts).

Row 8: Rep row 2.

Row 9: (K1, yfwd) twice, K11, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, K2togtbl, K2, yfwd, K11, (yfwd, K1) twice. (41 sts).

Row 10: Rep row 2.

Row 11: (K1, yfwd) twice, K13, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, K2togtbl, K2 yfwd, K13, (yfwd, K1)

twice. (47 sts).

Row 12: Rep row 2.

Row 13: (K1, yfwd) twice, K16, yfwd, PM, K1,

K2tog, yfwd, K5, yfwd, K2togtbl, K1, PM, yfwd, K16,

(yfwd, K1) twice. (53 sts).

Row 14: Rep row 6.

- Central Lace Panel -

The next 8 rows form pattern repeat, you will place the lace pattern on the centre 11 sts. At the same time continue to increase by 2 sts at either end of the shawl, and 1 st at either side of the lace panel on every RS row as set.

Stitch markers are at either side of the centre 11 sts panel for lace design. Move stitch marker up as each row is completed.

Row 1 (RS): (K1, yfwd) twice, knit to stitch marker, yfwd, SM, K2tog, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, K2togtbl, SM, yfwd, knit to last 2 sts, (yfwd, K1) twice. (59 sts).

Row 2 (WS): K3, purl to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 3: (K1, yfwd) twice, knit to stitch marker, yfwd, SM, K3, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, K2togtbl, K3, SM, yfwd, knit 2 last 2 sts, (yfwd, K1) twice. (65 sts).

Row 4: Rep row 2.

Row 5: (K1, yfwd) twice, knit to stitch marker, yfwd, SM, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, K2togtbl, K2, SM, yfwd, knit to last 2 sts,(yfwd, K1) twice (71 sts).

Row 6: Rep row 2.

Row 7: (K1, yfwd) twice, knit to stitch marker, yfwd, SM, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K5, yfwd, K2togtbl, K1, SM, yfwd, knit to last 2 sts, (yfwd, K1) twice. (77 sts).

Row 8: Knit to end.

Rows 1 to 8 form pattern, rep 8 more times. Continuing to increase as set with 2 sts at either end of the shawl, and 1 st at either side of the lace panel on every RS row. You'll have 267 sts.

- Central Lace Panel Border -

Change to 4mm needle

Row 1 (RS): (K1, yfwd) twice, knit to first st marker, yfwd, SM, K1, yfwd, K2togtbl, K5, K2tog, yfwd, K1, SM, yfwd, knit to last 2 sts, (yfwd, K1) twice. (273 sts).

Row 2 (WS): Knit to first stitch marker, SM, P11, SM, knit to end.

Row 3: (K1, yfwd) twice, knit to first st marker, yfwd, SM K2, yfwd, K2togtbl, K3, K2tog, yfwd, K2, SM, yfwd, knit to last 2 sts, (yfwd, K1) twice. Row 4: Knit to first stitch marker, SM, K2, P7, K2, SM, knit to end.

Row 5: (K1, yfwd) twice, knit to first st marker, yfwd, SM, K3, yfwd, K2togtbl, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, SM, yfwd, knit to last 2 sts, (yfwd, K1) twice. Row 6: Knit to first stitch marker, SM, K3, P5, K3, SM, knit to end.

Row 7: (K1, yfwd) twice, knit to first st marker, yfwd, SM, K4, yfwd, SI1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K4, SM, yfwd, knit to last 2 sts, (yfwd, K1) twice. Row 8: Knit to end.

- Garter Stitch Border -

Row 1 (RS): (K1, yfwd) twice, knit to first st marker, yfwd, K11, yfwd, knit to last 2 sts, (yfwd, K1) twice. (297 sts).

Row 2 (WS): Knit to end.

Row 3: (K1, yfwd, K1) twice, knit to last 2 sts,


(yfwd, K1) twice. (301 sts).

With WS facing, using 4.5mm needle cast off in knit.

- Making Up -

Using yarn needle, weave in any loose ends. Block and press to correct size if required.

- Shawl Chart -



	Knit on RS row / Purl on WS row
	Purl on RS row / Knit on WS row
О	yfwd yarn forward
1	K2tog knit 2 together
1	K2togtbl knit 2 together through the back loop
