

string of birds

This decorative string of birds will brighten up any room; knitted in cheery shades, they will perch perfectly. Make the string as long or short as you want, mixing and matching combinations of colours.

Workfrontandbackpanelfor each bird.

FRONT PANEL

Using 3.25 mm (US3) needles, cast on 5 sts. Row 1 (WS): Purl to end. Row 2: K1, M1 by picking up thestrandinbetweenstsand

knittingintotheback,K3,M1,

K1 (7 sts). Row 3: Purl to end. Row 4: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1 (9 sts).

Row 5: Purl to end. Row 6: K1, M1, K7, M1, K1 (11 sts).

Row 7: Purl to last st, M1, P1 (12 sts).

Row 8: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 sts).

Row 9: Repeat row 7 (15 sts). Row 10: K1, M1, K13, M1, K1 (17 sts).

Row 11: Repeat row 7 (18 sts).

SHAPE HEAD

Next row: K7, yo, slip next st, yarn back, turn.

Nextrow:SI1,P5,yarnback,SI1, yo, turn.

Nextrow: SI1, K4, yo, slip next st, yarn back, turn.

Nextrow:SI1,P4,yarnback,SI1, yo, turn.

Next row: SI1, K2, yo, slip next st, yarn back, turn. Nextrow:SI1,P1,yarnback,SI1, yo, turn.

Next row: SI1, knit to end, picking up strand around wrappedstitch,slippingonto the left-hand needle and workingtogetherwithstitch.

WORK TAIL

Next row: P6, yarn back, SI1, yo, turn.

Next row: SI1, knit to end. Nextrow:P4,yarnback,SI1,yo, turn.

Next row: SI1, knit to end. Next row: P2, yarn back, Sl1, yo, turn.

Next row: SI1, knit to end. Nextrow:Purltoend,picking up strand around wrapped stitch, slipping onto the lefthand needle, and working together with stitch.

Do not cast off, place on spare needle.

BACK PANEL

Using 3.25 mm (US3) needles, cast on 5 sts.

MATERIALS

Rowan Cotton Glace (100% cotton, approx. II6 m/ 127 yd per 50 g/1¾ oz ball)

- A shade 741 Poppy
- B shade 844 Green slate
- C shade 832 Persimmon
- D shade 814 Shoot
- E shade 841 Garnet

Toy stuffing

Sheets of felt fabric in the following colours:

BEAKS yellow

BIRD A tail - pink, wings - orange

BIRD B tail - green,

wings - turquoise BIRD C tail - ochre,

wings - pink

BIRD D tail - bright yellow, wings - mid-green

BIRD E tail - pink, wings - lilac

Threads to match felt colours

2 small black beads per bird, for eyes

String to thread birds onto

31 glass beads

I small bell

Spare needle

EOUIPMENT

I pair 3.25 mm (US 3) knitting needles

Pins

Tapestry needle

Sharp sewing needle

Approx. 25 sts x 32 rows = IO cm (4 in) in stocking

TEMPLATE

See page 125

Row 1 (WS): Purl to end. Row 2: K1, M1 by picking up thestrandinbetweenstsand knittingintotheback,K3,M1, K1 (7 sts).

Row 3: Purl to end. Row 4: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1 (9 sts).

Row 5: Purl to end. Row 6: K1, M1, K7, M1, K1 (11 sts).

Row 7: P1, M1, purl to end (12 sts).

Row 8: K1, M1, K10, M1, K1 (14 sts).

Row 9: Repeat row 7 (15 sts). Row 10: K1, M1, K13, M1, K1 (17 sts).

Row 11: Repeat row 7 (18 sts).

WORK TAIL

Next row: K6, yo, Sl1, yarn back, turn.

Next row: Sl1, purl to end. Next row: K4, yo, Sl1, yarn back, turn.

Next row: SI1, purl to end. Next row: K2, yo, SI1, yarn back, turn.

Next row: Sl1, purl to end. Nextrow: Knittoend, picking up strand around wrapped stitch, slipping onto the lefthand needle, and working together with stitch.

SHAPE HEAD

Next row: P7, yarn back, SI1, yo, turn.

Nextrow: SI1, K4, yo, SI1, yarn back, turn.

Nextrow:Sl1,P4,yarnback,Sl1, yo, turn.

Nextrow: SI1, K3, yo, SI1, yarn back, turn.

Nextrow:SI1,P2,yarnback,SI1, yo, turn.

Next row: SI1, knit to end,

picking up strand around wrappedstitch, slippingonto the left-hand needle and workingtogetherwithstitch. Nextrow: Purl to end, picking up strand around wrapped stitch, slipping onto the left-handneedleandworking together with stitch.

Cast offfront and backpanels together using the 3-needle cast-off method as follows: Holdwrongsidestogether and insertneedle through 1 st ston both needles, then knit. Repeat this for the 2nd st on needle.

Next, pass 1st st over the top of second and pass off the needle.

Repeat this until all sts have been cast off.

Breakoffyarnandslipthrough last sts – pull tight.

ASSEMBLY

Gently press front and back panels.

Next, sewfront and backseams leaving the bottomed geopen to insert stuffing.

Next, inserts tuffing; makes ure stuffing goes into the head and tail sections.

Once you are happy with the amount of stuffing, sew bottom edge.

BEAK

Cutasmallsquarefromyellow felt, approx. 1 cm (½ in). Foldinhalftoform2triangles. Thenpinandstitchintoposition at front of head.

TAIL

Cut a length of felt fabric approx.25cm(10in)longand







0.5 cm(¼in)wideand, using pictureas guide, fold to make approx. 4 loops.

Pinandstitchtheloopstogether to keep them in position.
Next,pinandstitchtheloopsto the top of the tail.

WINGS

Using the template, cut out wing shape from felt for each bird.

Pinintoposition on the cast-off edge at the top of the bird.

Stitchintopositiondowncentre of the wings along the back.

EYES

Using picture as guide, sew 1 beadto either side of the head for eyes.

STRINGING THE BIRDS

Lay out the birds in the order that you want them to be. Next, lay out the glass beads in the order you want them to be placed between the birds.

Measureoutthelengthofstring you require – make it longer thanyouneed as you can trim to the required length.

Starting at the bottom, work yourwayupthroughthebirds as follows:

Thread 3 beads, the bell, then 3 more beads onto the string. Knot the string to form a loop with 3 beads on both sides and the bellat centre bottom, then bring the needle threaded with

the string up through the centre of the bottom and out between the wings of the first bird.

Next thread 5 beads onto the string, and insert needle up through the next bird.

Repeatuntilall birdshave been threaded together.

Add the final set of 5 beads to

the top.
