

## Knitted Chevron Blanket

### - YOU WILL NEED -

#### Stylecraft Special Chunky

100g;144m/157yds;100% premium acrylic

- 2 x Cream (1005)
- 1 x Teal (1062)
- 1 x Silver (1203)
- 1 x Gold (1709)
- 1 x Copper (1029)
- 1 x Meadow (1065)
- 1 x Khaki (1027)
- 1 x Cloud Blue (1019)
- 1 x Aster (1003)
- 1 x Plum (1061)
- 1 x Emperor (1425)

1 pair 6mm circular needles  
(100cm length)

**NOTE:** Blanket is worked in rows.

**SIZE:** 145x100cm

### - ABBREVIATIONS -

**K:** Knit

**P:** Purl

**Kfb:** Knit into the front and back of next stitch, to increase 1 stitch

**K2tog:** Knit next 2 stitches together to decrease 1 stitch

**SKPO:** Slip next st (without knitting it), knit next stitch, pass slipped stitch over the knitted stitch, to decrease 1 stitch

### - PATTERN -

Using Teal, cast on 172 sts.

**Row 1:** K5, Kfb, \*K6, SKPO, K2tog, K6, (kfb) twice; rep from \* another 7 times, K6, SKPO, K2tog, K6, Kfb, K5.

**Row 2:** K

**Rows 3-8:** Rep Rows 1-2 another 3 times.

**Row 9:** As Row 1.

**Row 10:** K4, P to last 4 sts, K4.

**Rows 11-20:** Rep Rows 9-10 another 5 times.

**Rows 9-10** set the pattern.

Continue to rep Rows 9-10 in the following colour sequence:

12 Rows Silver / 6 Rows Gold / 6 Rows Cream / 10 Rows Copper / 10 Rows Meadow / 10 Rows Khaki / 6 Rows Cream / 6 Rows Cloud Blue / 10 Rows Aster / 12 Rows Plum / 10 Rows Emperor / 6 Rows Cream / 6 Rows Teal / 12 Rows Silver / 10 Rows Gold / 6 Rows Cream / 14 Rows Copper / 12 Rows Meadow / 6 Rows Khaki / 6 Rows Cream / 10 Rows Cloud Blue / 8 Rows Aster / 6 Rows Plum / 4 Rows Emperor.

Continue with Emperor and rep Rows 1-2 another 4 times.

Cast off, maintaining Row 1 pattern.

Weave all ends into wrong side and trim.

Spray the blanket with cold water, pin edges flat and leave to dry.
