STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

alt - alternate beg - beginning cm - centimetres cont - continue dec - decrease(ing) DK - double knitting foll - following g - grammes in - inch(es) inc - increase(ing) k - knit A – shade A B – shade B mm – millimetres 0 - no stitches, times or rows p – purl psso - pass slipped stitch over rem - remain(ing) rep – repeat rs – right side sI - slip I stitch knitways st(s) - stitch(es) tog - together ws - wrong side yfwd - yarn forward ml - pick up loop between last and next stitch and knit into the back of this loop.

MITTENS (BOTH ALIKE)

Using 3 mm needles, thumb method and B, cast on 26 [28:30:32] sts. Ist Row. Knit. This row will now be referred to as g-st (garter stitch). Work in g-st for 4 [4:5:5]cm, (11/2 $[1\frac{1}{2}:2:2]$ in), ending with a ws row. Next Row. K8 [9:9:10], inc in next st, k8 [8:10:10], inc in next st, k8 [9:9:10]. 28 [30:32:34] sts. Change to 4mm needles and using A, proceed as follows:-Ist Row. Knit. 2nd Row. Purl. These 2 rows will now be referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch). Working in st-st cont until mitten measures 8 [9:10:11]cm, (3 [3¹/₂:4:4]

measures 8 [9:10:11]cm, (3 $[3\frac{1}{2}:4]$ in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE TOP

1st Row. (K1, s1, k1, psso, k8 [9:10:11], k2tog, k1) twice. 24 [26:28:30] sts. 2nd Row. Purl.

3rd Row. (K1, s1, k1, psso, k6 [7:8:9], k2tog, k1) twice. 20 [22:24:26] sts.
4th Row. Purl.
5th Row. (K1, s1, k1, psso, k4 [5:6:7], k2tog, k1) twice. 16 [18:20:22] sts.
6th Row. Purl.
Cast off rem 16 [18:20:22] sts.

TO MAKE UP

Join side seam reversing sewing for turnback. Join top seam. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

BONNET

Using 3 mm needles, thumb method and B, cast on 77 [79:81:83] sts. Ist Row. (rs). Knit. This row will now be referred to as g-st (garter stitch). Work in g-st for 2cm, (in), ending with a ws row. Change to 4mm needles and using A, proceed as follows:-Next Row. Knit. Next Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2. Next Row. Knit. Next Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2. Next Row. K3 [2:3:2], * k2tog, yfwd, k2, rep from * to last, 2 [1:2:1] sts, k2 [**|:2:|**]. Next Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2. Proceed as follows:-Ist Row. Knit. 2nd Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2. 1st and 2nd rows set st-st (stocking stitch) with g-st edge. Working in st-st with g-st edge cont until bonnet measures 10 [11:12:13] cm, (4 [4 :4 :5]in), ending with a rs row. Next Row. K2, purl to last 2 sts, dec 2 [0:1:0] sts evenly across row for 1st, and 3rd sizes only and inc

0 [1:0:2] sts evenly across row for 2nd and 4th sizes only, k2. 75 [80:80:85] sts.

SHAPE CROWN

Ist Row. * K2tog, k3, rep from * to end. 60 [64:64:68] sts. 2nd and Every Alt Row. Purl. 3rd Row. * K2tog, k2, rep from * to end. 45 [48:48:51] sts. 5th Row. * K2tog, k1, rep from * to end. 30 [32:32:34] sts. 7th Row. * (K2tog) 15 [16:16:17] times. 15 [16:16:17] sts. 8th Row. PI [0:0:1], (p2tog) 7 [8:8:8] times. 8 [8:8:9] sts. Break off yarn, run yarn through rem 8 [8:8:9] sts, draw up and fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Join crown seam. Sew on ribbon. Cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

SHOES (BOTH ALIKE)

Using 3 mm needles, thumb method and A, cast on 35 [37:39:41] sts. Ist Row. (rs). Knit. This row will now be referred to as g-st (garter stitch). Working in g-st (throughout) proceed as follows:44 2nd Row. KI, mI, kI6 [17:18:19], mI, kl, ml, kl6 [17:18:19], ml, kl. 39 [41:43:45] sts. 3rd to 5th Row. Knit. 6th Row. K1, m1, k17 [18:19:20], m1, k3, ml, kl7 [18:19:20], ml, kl. 43 [45:47:49] sts. 7th to 9th Row. Knit. 10th Row. K1, m1, k18 [19:20:21], m1, k5, m1, k18 [19:20:21], m1, k1. 47 [49:51:53] sts. Using B, work 2 rows in g-st. Next Row. K15 [15:16:16], k2tog, k13 [15:15:17], k2tog, k15 [15:16:16]. 45 [47:49:51] sts. Next Row. Knit. Next Row. K2tog, k13 [13:14:14], k2tog, k|| [|3:|3:|5], k2tog, k|3 [|3: 14:14], k2tog. 41 [43:45:47] sts. Next Row. Knit. Next Row. K14 [14:15:15], k2tog, k9 [11:11:13], k2tog, k14 [14:15:15]. 39 [41:43:45] sts. Next Row. Knit. Next Row. K14 [14:15:15], k2tog, k7 [9:9:11], k2tog, k14 [14:15:15]. 37 [39:41:43] sts. Next Row. Knit. Next Row. K14 [14:15:15], k2tog, k5 [7:7:9], k2tog, k14 [14:15:15]. 35 [37:39:41] sts. Cast off rem 35 [37:39:41] sts knitways.

TO MAKE UP

Join foot and back seams. Sew ribbon to top edge of back seam. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
