Winter Dolls A Crochet Pattern By Annaboo's House



Meet Big Pip, Nat and Baby Mo.

These cute winter dolls will brighten up any dreary day and are a quick, easy make.

Stitches and Abbreviations:

I use US crochet terms, so single crochet here is the SAME as UK double crochet

Chain (ch)
Single Crochet (sc)
Stitches (sts)
Single Crochet 2 Together (sc2tog)
Slip Stitch (sl st)

To Single Crochet 2 Together (Sc2tog)

Insert hook into next stitch
Yarn over, pull up a loop
(You will have 2 loops on your hook)
Insert hook into next stitch
Yarn over, pull up another loop
(You will have 3 loops on your hook)
Yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

This pattern is worked in rounds, in a continuous spiral of stitches.

You'll need your stitch marker to mark where you

begin each round.



Big Pip (Large sized Grey doll)



Pip measures approx 24cms tall

You will need:

- 50g of each Rico Creative Cotton Aran in Grey (shade 28), and White (shade 80) This larger doll uses a lot of white yarn, particularly in making the pompom. I would advise buying an extra 50g ball to be on the safe side.

 Alternatively, you could use a matching white yarn from your stash to make the pompom.
- 50g ball of Sirdar Country Style in Fawn (shade 398) NB This will be enough for all three dolls
- 4mm and 3.5mm crochet hooks
- Stitch Marker
- Toy Stuffing
- Tapestry (blunt) needle for sewing in ends and embroidering star motif
- 2x 11mm Black Safety Eyes
- 65mm Clover pompom maker

Head

Use Sirdar yarn and a 4mm hook

Beginning with 'chin' and working up

1. Sc 6 in magic ring OR

Ch 2, Sc 6 in 2nd chain from hook (6sts)

- 2. 2sc in each sc (12)
- 3. 2sc in each sc (24)
- 4. Sc 24
- 5.(Sc 1, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (36)
- 6. Sc 36 (36)
- 7. (Sc 1, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (54)

8-18. Sc 54

- 19. (Sc 1, sc2tog) repeat around (36)
- 20. Sc 36
- 21. (Sc 1, sc2tog) repeat around (24)
- 22. Sc 24

Cut yarn, leaving 2 arm lengths to complete the head later.

Insert safety eyes between rows 12-13, with 11 stitches between them.



Body

Use Rico Grey yarn and a 4mm hook

Beginning with 'neck' and working down

1. Sc 6 in magic ring OR

Ch 2, Sc 4 in 2nd chain from hook (6sts)

- 2. 2sc in each sc (12)
- 3. (Sc 1, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (18)
- 4. Sc 18
- 5. (Sc 1, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (27)
- 6. (Sc 2, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (36)

7-12. Sc 36

13. (Sc 2, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (48)

14-17. Sc 48

Stop here to attach the head to the body. The head, with hat and pompom are quite heavy, so it is worth sewing them securely together.

You can always make the body and head completely and sew them together at the end, if you prefer.

Complete Body

18. (Sc 7, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (54)

19-24. Sc 54

25. (Sc 1, sc2tog) repeat around (36)

26-28. Sc 36

Stuff

29. BLO (Sc2tog) repeat around (18)

30. (Sc2tog) repeat around (9)

Leave the ends to sew in after you have embroidered the star motif.



Complete Head

Complete Head

23. (Sc2tog) repeat around (12)

Stuff

24. (Sc2tog) around (6)

Sew closed

Hat

Use Rico White yarn and a 3.5mm hook Beginning with top and working down

1. Sc 6 in magic ring OR

Ch 2, Sc 6 in 2^{nd} chain from hook (6sts)

- 2. 2sc in each sc (12)
- 3. 2sc in each sc (24)
- 4. Sc 24
- 5. (Sc 1, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (36)
- 6. Sc 36 (36)
- 7. (Sc 1, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (54)

8-19. Sc 54

Fasten off end.

Make 65mm pompom and sew to top of hat. I would advise making the gloves first, to ensure you have enough yarn.



Add star embellishments to the hat and body using contrasting yarn.

Sew bottom of body closed and fasten off.

Gloves (Make 2)

Use Rico yarn in Grey and White and a 4mm hook
Start with white. Beginning with 'hand' and working
up

2. (Sc 1, 2sc in next sc) repeat around (9)

3-6. Sc 9

To make thumb, ch 2, sl st in 2^{nd} chain from hook, sl st in base of same stitch.

7. (Change to Grey yarn) Sc 9 (make sure the thumb sticks out)

8-12. Sc 9

Leave long ends and sew to body.
