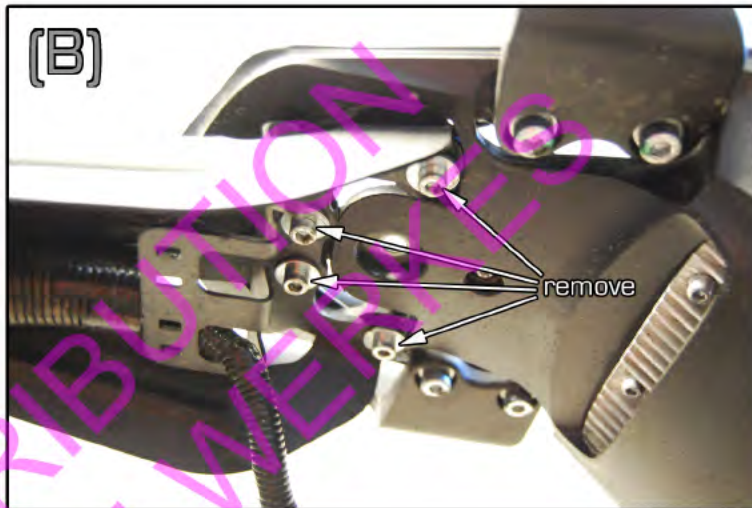

### DISASSEMBLY:

- 1) Remove seat (1-allen bolt underneath tail).
- 2) Unplug wire harness at connection shown in \*FIG (A). Feed wire out of storage area.
- 3) Remove rear fender assembly (4- allen bolts). \*FIG (B)
- 4) Break down rear fender assembly. Set taillight, spacer and wire harness aside \*FIG's (C) & (D).

### INSTALLATION:

- 1) Install Turn Signals to supplied Fender Assembly as shown in \*FIG (E).
- 2) Insert taillight into Fender Assembly and secure with 2 6x16 Allen Bolts and Washers.
- 3) Position spacer onto Fender Assembly as shown in \*FIG (F).
- 4) Secure Fender Assembly to tail using stock hardware.
- 5) Route wires up through hole on left side of tail.
- 6) Plug in stock wire harness.
- 7) Connect Turn Signal wires to wire harness using supplied connectors \*NOTE\* see back of signal package. Longer wires on harness are the ground wires. Shorter wires are positive.
- 8) Check lighting for proper function.
- 9) Secure wires as desired using supplied Zip-ties.
- 10) Replace seat.
