2013 Triumph Daytona 675 Limited Fender Eliminator

- REMOVE: Rear seat.
- REMOVE: Fender (4- bolts, unplug wire harness) **FIG (A) and bushings shown in **FIG (D).
- UNBOLT: Turn signals (2- allen bolts) and let them hang.
- REMOVE: Reflector (pry off with screw driver) and license plate bracket (3- allen bolts). **FIG (B)
- SEPARATE: Two halves of fender and unplug license light and turn signals. **FIG (C)
- REMOVE: Mounting bracket and wiring harness from fender **FIG (C). Set the rest of the fender assembly (including lights) aside.
- REMOVE: Front seat (lift corners of seat to reveal allen bolts) **FIG (E)
- DISCONNECT: Battery and remove it from its tray (set aside).
- REMOVE: Rear footpeg mounting brackets (2- bolts per side) see **FIG (F).
- ADHERE: License Light and Turn Signals to License Pan **FIG (I). Side license light wires through Conduit. Mount license plate with 6x10 Allen Bolts
- SECURE: License Pan using 4- 8x12 allen bolts supplied **FIG (F). Route wires as shown in **FIG's (F&G) and connect using supplied connectors.
- INSTALL: Stock mounting bracket with Aluminum Spacer and stock rubber cushion above (2- 6x20 Allen Bolts & washers from above) **FIG (H)
- SECURE: Cover Plate as shown **FIG (I) using 6x10 allen bolts.
- REPLACE: Battery, check lighting function, and replace seats
