## Triumph Speed Triple 1200 slip=on exhaust



## **REMOVAL:**

- 1) Remove belly pan and heat shield (slide heat shield forward).
- 2) Remove stock exhaust canister (1- bolt, 2- clamps). \*FIG (A)
- 3) Remove servo motor from subframe \*FIG (B). \*\*NOTE\*\* This step requires patience, proper tools, and good lighting.
- 4) Remove servo motor cover (phillips screws).
- 5) Remove cables and unplug servo motor.
- 6) Remove Exhaust Chamber (1- bolt, 1- clamp). \*FIG (A)

## INSTALL:

- 1) Plug-in Servo Eliminator and secure with zip-tie. \*FIG (C)
- 2) Install Exhaust Hanger Bracket to brake mount bolts. \*FIG (D)
- 3) Secure Heat Shield Mounting Bracket (2- bolts). FIG (E)
- 4) Install WerkesUSA Exhaust Canister (1- bolt, 1- clamp).
- 5) Install heat shield and belly pan.
- 6) Clean exhaust of finger prints and grime with WD-40 (or similar).


