**Terms and Conditions**

In addition to the rules and regulations established by the World Barista Championship ([www.worldbaristachampionship.com](http://www.worldbaristachampionship.com)), the following terms and conditions apply to the South African competition as follows:

- Competitors must compete in the region of his/her residence or employment. Should a competitor need to compete in another region, a letter of request should be sent to the Barista Championship Committee stating reasons for not being able to compete in his/her region. The Barista Championship Committee will at its discretion grant permission for this.
- All competitors should be South African residents.
- All competitors should have a valid passport, not be prohibited from travel to the country in which the World Barista Championships will take place and be available to travel to the World Barista Championship. Should this not be the case the competitor will not be allowed in the top 6 winner range.
- The National Championship will for the year of his/her title be the representative for all baristas in South Africa. As such, he/she will, within reason, make him/her available to attend and assist with events, trainings, seminars, talks and competitions as required from time to time by SCASA.
- Applications for sponsorship to SCASA must be submitted in writing and will be decided upon at the sole discretion of the 2016 Barista Championship Committee.
- All competitor/competitor companies must be a member of SCASA. Membership fee is R500 Contact Amanda Pyne-James at [amanda@imbizi.co.za](mailto:amanda@imbizi.co.za)
- The entrance fee per SCASA member is R250 for the first 2 competitors each, thereafter R500 per competitor.
- Competitors may not serve on the Barista Championship Committee or sub-committees for the complete cycle of competitions of the year of competing. Should there be any reason enough to overrule this, written approval from the BCC should be granted.
- The top 6 winners of each region (PE, KZN, CT, and JHB) will agree to compete at the National Barista Championship to be held in late 2016. Should this not be possible for any reason, they undertake to inform the BCC at the earliest possible date to allow the next highest ranking competitor from that region to compete in their place.
- The BCC encourages anyone to compete at the competitions and wish all competitors well with their performances.
- SCASA reserves the right to change any Terms and Conditions.
