TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In addition to the Rules and Regulations established by the World Barista Championship (www.worldbaristachampionship.com), the following Terms and Conditions apply to the South African Competition :

- Competitors must compete in the region of their residence or employment. Should a competitor need to complete in another region, a letter of request should be sent to the Barista Championship Committee (BCC) stating the reasons for not being able to compete in their region. The BCC will at its discretion grant permission for this. All competitors should be legal South African residents.
- All competitors should have a valid passport, not be prohibited from travel to the
- country in which the World Barista Championships will take place and be available to travel to the WBC. Should this not be case, the competitor will not be allowed in the Top Six Winner range.

The SA National Champion, will for the year of their title, be the representative for all baristas in South Africa, i.e. they will, within reason, make themselves available to

• attend and assist with events, training, seminars, talks and competitions as required from time to time by SCASA.

Competitors may not serve on the Barista Committee or sub-committees for the complete cycle of the competitions of the year of competing. Should there be any

- reason enough to overrule this, written approval from the BCC would need to be granted.
- The top 6 barista winners, top 2 latte artist and top 2 cup tasters of each Region will agree to compete at the National Finals. Should this not be possible for any reason, they undertake to inform the BCC at the earliest date to allow the next highest ranking.
- competitor from that Region to compete in their place.
